RESCUE RADIO:

'Rescue Radio One' is in operation at Jack Richardsons'.

Frequencies available: 155.16 (MRA) & 47.46 (FWD)

'Rescue Radio Two' is in operation at Dave Lovelocks'.

Frequencies available: 155.16 (MRA) & REACT Base (CB)

Note: Avoid using 'Base' to refer to either station, which can be confused with 'Basecamp'.

NOTES

1. A rescue member laid a rope on the road, right next to a road flare.

2. The road from the gate in the saddle, down to and past Sycamore Reservoir is CLOSED to ALL vehicular traffic, including US!
