"St Marks"--St Marks, Presbyterian Church; half block W of Alvernon, use 2nd St entrance.

"Hitchcock"--Hitchcock Picnic Area, Mt Lemmon Hwy, milepost 12. Use the last picnic area, using the road that turns to the right, in the sharp curve in the hiway.

"AHSC 6120"--Arizona Health Science Center (University Hosp.) Use south doors, 2nd floor. 6120 is on 6th floor to the right.

"Browns"-----1207 E Hedrick: 1 block south of Ft. Lowell on Mountain, west on Hedrick to first house on left.

"Davis"-----2601 N Bahana: North on Indian Ruins from Tanque Verde, west on Nasumpta to to Bahana.

TRAINING OPERATION for June will be held at the Browns, on Saturday evening, June 23. See MEETING PLACES for directions.

Vehicular operations will be discussed, with practice on minimum clearance driving and the use of observers. Actual driving will be very short in distance, with 4x4's NOT required. Many of these techniques are applicable to ALL vehicles.

Several telephone poles have been erected for technical practice as we did at the fair. Specific attention will be on belays, belays, with a dynamic belay system rigged. The Browns have a swimming pool, come and enjoy!

FREE HIKE for June will walk the Green Mtn Trail from San Pedro Vista to Hitchcock Picnic Area. Meet at Tanque Verde & Sabino at 8:30 am, Sun. 17 June.
