## TRAINING ACTIVITIES IN JULY & AUGUST

SARA CALL SHEET has a modified format. Each pager is responsible for that list of people. If a list includes callers, one of them will ensure the rest are notified. Otherwise, the first person called should continue down that list until another person is notified, and so on. The procedure is not different from what is has been (or should have been).

The order of people on a list is fixed; more active people should be called first, but a person not responding is welcome to make the calls for that list.  
Not on the list are out-of-town people, or people not active due to lack of response, NO DUES (as promised), inactive first-aid, or Trainees without an orientation. The Communications people will put you on when you are ready.
