October training preview:

EMT REFRESHER course will be oriented to remote area injuries, taught by Jeff Beeley this fall at Pima College. This will be the intense, 5 day course, and will be held only if 20 or more sign up. The dates will be dependent upon the consensus of those who enroll.

COUNCIL MEDICAL STANDARDS: suggestions have been given to each group for review and comment. The following is expected to provoke much comment:

Advanced First Aid & Emergency Care (or EMT Basic) shall be the MINIMUM standard for field qualification for Council operations.

This standard (upon acceptance) shall apply to all new members. The present standard will apply to all others for a period of 18 months. Thereafter, the new standard will apply to all people.

CPR is recommended, but not required.

FOUR WHEEL DRIVE BYLAWS To be submitted to a vote of the members are two items: 1) Amending ART.III, Sect.2 concerning classes of members of the organization. The wording is being worked out, and may include dues, medical, and training clauses. 2) The Rules & Regulations will be submitted to a vote.

COMMUNICATIONS: Still no more crystals. MRA is still the primary frequency.
