### TRAINING ACTIVITIES

- 1) Helicopter Operations will be presented by the Air Rescue crew. Hoist procedures are scheduled, with a demonstration. Meet inside the main gate (South end of Craycroft) at 9:00 Am on Sat. 10 Nov.
- -Note: The Basic Training session rescheduled for Sat. & Sun., 17 & 18 November is cancelled.
- BOARD MEETINGS rescheduled due to Thanksgiving will be announced later.
- COMMUNICATIONS: Still no more crystals. MRA is still the primary frequency.

MEDICAL: The following policy was adopted by the Council on 17 October:

The MINIMUM medical training standard required for field operations of SARCI (the Council shall be a current qualification in Americal Red Cross "Advanced First Aid & Emergence Care", with the following exceptions:

a) Trainees (or equivalent): "Standard Firs Aid & Personal Safety" is allowed for no more

than one year.

- b) Other emergency first aid training may be accepted at the discretion of the Council.
- c) Posse: "Standard First Aid & Persona Safety" shall be the minimum qualification.
- d) Divers: exempt from these qualifications.
- e) Anyone without Advanced First Aid (or greater qualification) is strongly encouraged to upgrade to full Council standards.

These standards are effective immediately for new members. These standards will be effective on Nov. 1, 1980 for present members Until then, "Std. F. A. & Pers. Safety" is the minimum.

SARA MEDICAL QUALIFICATIONS: "Advanced First Aid & Emergency Care" is the minimum standard for all SARA members, effective immediately (The two people with Std First Aid are okay until it expires)
