SEARCH AND RESCUE VOLUNTEERS:

The purpose of <u>any</u> search and rescue organization is to <u>help the victim</u>. We some times lose sight of this goal by getting wrapped up in our own bureaucracy: rules, regulations, titles and so on. Granted, we need some structure for smooth operation but the main concern of the <u>victim</u> is "Can you help me <u>now</u>?" or sometimes, "Can you save my life?"

We all work as a team, but each of us must be independently responsible for providing the best possible emergency care and concern which may make or break an operation. Another human being may MEED us.

Practices, trainings, and first aid courses are all methods of improving ourselves and our team work with other Council groups. Are we really prepared? Remember, people who are field qualified for Council operations have at least Standard First Aid (lecture course).
