Each group must be responsible for the competence of its own members, both new and present, and should not have members on call-outs unless they have clearly established their qualifications at training sessions or previous field operations.

Jan. 17	Full call-out for rescue of 3 teen-aged female Indian students from Santa Rosa Boarding School. Helicopters from DM, DPS, & Customs participated in rescue. Subjects were removed by hoist from Santa Rosa Mt. Subsequently found to be uninjured at Arizona Medical Center.
Jan. 20	Search for missing 31-yr-old female in area of I-10 & Ruthrauff. Search called off early evening and matter referred to deputies.
