Rich Kunz reports that the two technical training sessions at Tanque Verde Falls proved to participants that a ground evacuation from the base of the main falls coming up the path of the trolley system without using the trolley line would be preferable to the route up to the cliff, traversing downstream and then up the gulley. Both routes were tested with the first one taking only 20 minutes for the actual haul (excluding setup time) using two people plus the stokes litter. The latter took approximately 2 hours.

The Sheriff's Posse reports that they have revised their system by dividing their members into two groups. The East group is coordinated by George Gregory with Al Bagley and Bill Prout acting as team leaders. The West group coordinator is Butch Lieber assisted by team leaders Bill Sharp and Slim Grabke. Six posse members will be under each leader.

The Posse Board and General Meetings for December will be postponed until early January, dates TBA after the November meeting.

A Posse training program is being planned which includes a hight search and also an overnight in Sabino Canyon, date TBA. The training program is headed by George Gregory and Bill Prout in close association with SARCI.
