With the profusion of radios we now have among rescue members it's particularly important that we all use discretion and observe proper radio conduct, particularly while enroute to a callout. Please wait until you arrive at rendezvous to find out the specifics of the operation.

Another reminder: We should all be more vigilant of casual comments made before, during or after a rescue. Innocent, fun remarks may be overheard by the victim, family or friends and sometimes painfully misunderstood. Let's all remember to conduct ourselves in our highest manner of professionalism.

Mykle encourages anyone calling his recorded message for callout information to please identify yourself or leave a message as it's the only way he has of knowing that this service is indeed being used. Your name and a "thank you" will do.

Do you keep a spare life jacket for the victim with your rescue gear? There appeared to be a shortage at the last river rescue. Remember, any rescue personnel going into the river during a rescue must have a full wet suit, helmet, footgear and PFD (not a Buoyancy Compensator!). A helmet and PFD are required for those assisting on the bank.
