FROM THE EDITORS

Our SAR equipment trucks have been called "SARA-1, SARA-2, and RESCUE-3". We also have designators for the MEDS system. People have a hard time remembering the first three, let alone remembering the MEDS numbers.

Other agencies have changed their vehicle designators so they are compatible on each radio system. It appears appropriate for us to do the same, and comments have been encouraging. So, we will request a third designator.

On SAR radios, we'll probably just use the number. We will work on retiring the present names, and using the following:

MEDS: "RESCUE-330" "RESCUE-331" "RESCUE-332"

SAR: "330" "331" "332"

OLD NAME: "SARA-1" "SARA-2" "RESCUE-3"

The Sheriff's Department has restructured the badge numbers assigned to each officer, basically compressing the list so that all officers have numbers of three or fewer digits. The County trunked radio system has an I.D. number programmed into each radio, which for officers is the badge number. Whenever a radio transmits, this "LID" number appears on the display of other radios. This makes it a lot easier to sort out radio traffic, especially in areas where communication is difficult (the LID may make it when voice does not). Even when a person cannot speak, you know which radio is being used, and where it is (or should be). Other officers can provide backup very easily. Otherwise, you know who might have an "open mike", or whose radio is being used without authorization, stolen or not. The only radio that we have on this system is in Rescue 3 (Rescue 332?!), and it's LID is on a label on the radio, if needed.

So, everyone has to forget old badge numbers, and learn new ones. Here's a list of the officers with whom we often work:

SUN 08 DEC: CALL 96.084 Rescue of a 34 year old female hiker on the Box Camp Trail. She started in the morning on a guided hike, and became exhausted, but was persuaded to continue with frequent rest breaks. Teams met up with the group of three near the Dam Site on the Sabino Canyon Trail. She rode out by horse the rest of the way. 11 people, 26 hours

SUN 15 DEC: CALL 96.085 Search for 55 and 60 year old male hunters overdue east of Mt.Fagan (north end of Santa Ritas). Ranger 38 spotted their vehicle without sign of the hunters. Sgt.Jim picked up one hunter along the highway. He was unclear which road he had walked out on, but remembered a large cattle tank near where he separated from the other hunter. Two dog teams tried to find the road he came out on. A foot team found a large cattle tank and teams searched that area the rest of the night. At dawn TJ went back to the hunter's RV to get the guide and discovered that the second hunter had returned during the night. The guide had left notes (very small) on a couple of our vehicles left on the Sonita Highway. 9 people, 74 hours, R38



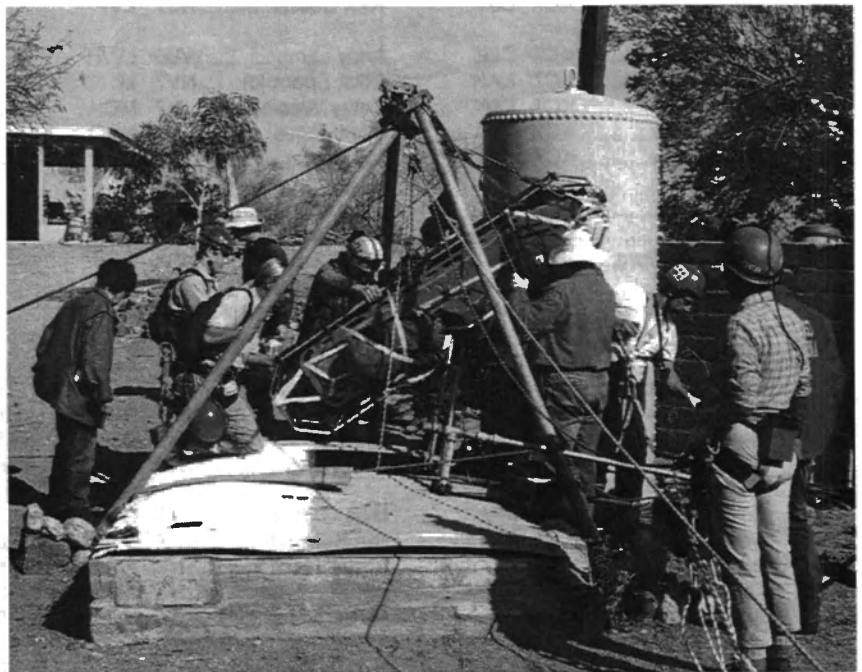
MON 16 DEC: CALL 96.086 Search for a 25 year old female overdue on the Butterfly Trail. She started late in the afternoon and lost the trail near the Crystal Springs Trail junction. By sunset she had not found the trail again and started walking toward the lights of the Mount Bigelow towers. Ranger 38 spotted the hiker "flicking her Bic". The GPS coordinates indicated that she was east of the junction, and above the trail by a few hundred feet in elevation. Deputy Pat and the Mt. Lemmon Deputy made voice contact from the top of the ridge near cabins in Bear Wallow, and she said she was not injured. A foot team arrived about 02:30, warmed her up, then walked her down to the trail and back to the trailhead. 9 people, 44 hours, R38

TUE 17 DEC: CALL 96.??? Search for 16 year old male presumed drowned at Pena Blanca Lake in Santa Cruz County. He was with three others on a paddle boat taken from the dock near the restaurant around midnight. The boat swamped and all four ended up in the water. Three of them made it to shore. Divers and K-9's searched several days without success.

NO RECORDS RECEIVED FOR ANY DAY'S ACTIVITIES

THU 26 DEC: CALL 96.087 Search for missing 26 year old male in a rural area west of Panther Peak, Saguaro Park West. He had walked in the are of the peak previously, and he had hung out at the blood bank, needing money for more booze. Search teams had been in the field briefly when people at the latter advised of his arrival. 14 people, 41 hours, Ranger 38

FRI 27 DEC: Call 96.088 Search for overdue hunter, a Sheriff's Deputy, in the Willow Canyon area. Two hunters had agreed to meet at noon, one had taken a deer and was slow getting out. It took Ranger 38 to stimulate radio contact with the hunter, who was okay. 11 people, 18 hours, Ranger 38, and lots of Sheriff's Dept. attention.

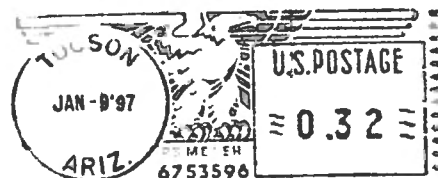
