SUN 2 MAR: CALL 97.005 Search for a 63 year old male hiker overdue at Catalina State Park. Ranger 38 spotted a fire, where Deputy Doug found our subject 100 yards upstream from Romero Pools, then kept the fire going so a searcher could dry off after falling into the stream. 11 people, 60 hours, R38


MON 17 Mar: CALL 97.006 Rescue of a 32 year old male at Seven Falls. He slipped on the smooth rock above the lower pool and broke his ankle. Teams splinted the ankle and helped him cross the stream. He was carried by stokes up to the trail junction, then rode Nacho to the trailhead.

14 people, 58 hours, C511 FBI

THR 20 MAR: CALL 97.007 Search for a 45 year old female hiker overdue in Sabino Canyon. She missed a dinner engagement. and we were called after midnight. Foot teams started up Sabino and Bear Trails, and a Posse team started from the Prison Camp, finding her at Sycamore Dam, thirsty, hungry, and tired. She rode the tram and hiked to Hutchs' Pool and back, missing the turn at Pine Creek. She hiked three times up to the gate in Upper Sycamore Saddle and back to the dam, deciding that was not the way to go. She rode by horse to the saddle, then with Deputy Doug back to Sabino.
