

Presenter: Ken Mroczek 743-8754 When: January 17 at 7:00 AM

Where: Meet at 106, carpool to Butterfly Trailhead.

The Snow and Rescue Training will cover winter survival Techniques for traveling across snow and use of technical haul and lower systems. Bring your lunch and dress warm. No special gear is required other than your SARA pack. If you do own crampons or an ice ax bring them. All members and candidates are welcome to come to the training.

Map & Compass Training

Presenter: Jeff Brucker 886-2528 When: Sunday January 18

Where: 08:30, Oracle & Magee, carpool to Catalina Park. The Tucson Orienteering Club will have courses set up for five skill levels, from beginner to advanced. There will be a short beginner's class, and then we will each do a course

individually (or with a partner). After the course, we will do another class at the intermediate level. There will be a cost of \$3 each to do the courses, or \$2 each if you go with a partner. (The Orienteering Club operates on a bare-bones budget, and the fee represents the true cost of the supplies used in the course.) You will probably learn more in a couple of hours of orienteering than you have in many years of hiking, and I highly recommend this training, no matter what your present skill level.

BLS Course: CPR for the Professional Rescuer

Adult, infant and child CPR, one and two-man rescuer, use of pocket resuscitation mask and bag valve mask. Red Cross certificate upon successful completion of course. Cost \$20. A pocket rescue mask is required (\$11.00 at class). Sunday, January 18: call Frances Walker, 790-9399

WED 17 DEC CALL 97.062 Rescue of a 30 year old male reported as a fall victim in Pima Canyon. The victim was on a Jeff Brucker - SAHC morning hike. Apparently the victim just collapsed, possibly hitting his head. Jeff sent a companion out for help. In the mean time the victim showed signs of a possible stroke. After several minutes the victim recovered somewhat and was able to start hiking out. Rural Metro paramedics met up with the group a little ways up the trail while Ranger 38 was also able to make visual contact. O₂ was given to the victim and hiked the rest of the way out. 6 people, 8 hours, R38, RMFD
