Pagers

Service for Verizon pagers has become difficult since their Tucson offices closed and our accounts transferred to Phoenix. We may be required to purchase our pagers, otherwise turn them in and discontinue receiving pages. So, we will not be issuing any more paperwork authorizing members to start service with Verizon.

SARCI pagers are now using Arch Paging. We are working with them to set up service suitable for SAR people. The cost for alpha pagers will be less than \$8.00 per month, including insurance (but there is a deductible). A voice mailbox is available for another \$1.00/month. SARCI Authorization paperwork will be required to obtain this price, and to add the SAR group numbers. Arch also requires a credit application. Depending upon your credit, there may be initial costs that include part of the pager cost, a deposit, and/or prepaid service. Billing is quarterly. We expect to be able to support new individual pager accounts at some time during May.

SUN 07 APR CALL 2001.020 19 people 63 hours Ranger 38, RMFD

A 33 year old female peeled off the top of her middle toe while wading at Seven Falls. She waited for help at the foot of the trail, while teams waded up the trail with higher than normal stream flow. Her foot was packaged so she could ride a horse, and that made the rest of the call pretty easy.

THU 12 APR CALL 2001.021 11 people 14 hours Ranger 38

An 86 year old male alzheimer's patient escaped from his residence near the foot of the Catalina Highway. He was seen leaving about 01:30, but family and Sheriff's officers were unable to find him by dawn. Our basecamp was being set up in the parking area at milepost zero, and teams noticed the subject across the highway, coming out of the bushes where he had rested until it got light. He was scratched from the brush, but was otherwise fine.

SAT 14 APR CALL 2001.022 12 people 12 hours Ranger 38, USFS

Chris Faulkner (son of Tom and Barb) was exploring the slopes above the Dam Site in Sabino Canyon. He and his companion were working their way up a steep gully, when Chris was unable to continue up, and didn't think he could get down safely. So his companion went for help. Ranger 38 flew up canyon as volunteers were arriving at the gate, and found a person matching Chris' description just getting up to the trail. He ran to the end of the road to be sure that we knew he was okay. He had plenty of time to reevaluate his situation, and found a safe way to descend the gully, and came up another way.

WED 25 APR CALL 2001.023 10 people 10 hours USFS, RMFD

A 79 year old hiker was walking with his wife down the Phoneline Trail from the end of the road. He had a quadruple bypass surgery relatively recently, and it was a warm day, and his energy level didn't last all the way down. USFS Officer Margaret met the group at the top of the Phoneline Link Trail. He was continuing to walk slowly, and met the Rural Fire medics who started an IV. The party was at the foot of the trail as volunteers arrived to assist him wading across the stream, easier than an unstable person trying to rock-hop.
