COMMUNICATIONS & EQUIPMENT

Arch is closing their Tucson store. They will keep two reps in town to service accounts. We have a programming cradle that can add group codes on private Arch pagers (on the proper frequency). In another change, Arch will no longer provide their \$0 lease on new SAR pagers. New customers will need to purchase their pagers at \$140. There will be no change for existing customers.

Group pages on the Verizon system may be discontinued at the end of November. This will reduce the calls required to put out pages (and update Audix) from 5 to 3.

That countdown at the end of Audix messages is intended to cut down on Hang-ups that each gets recorded as a separate voice mail message. When a callout message is needed, it can take up to 10 minutes to clear all the empty messages. So ... PLEASE hang up before the end of the message.

You may ask for email notice instead of a printed copy, typically sent on Friday or Saturday before the SARA Meeting. There are now about 50 people on the email distribution list. MON 15 OCT CALL 1.072 4 - 9 people 419 hours

Two elderly fishermen were missing at Sunrise Lake in Apache County. Their boat was found along the shore. The body of one was found soon after the search started. SRDI was requested to help search for the second person. Over several days, the dogs continued to identify a particular spot in the middle of the shallow, weed filled lake. The local divers were unwilling to dive in the weeds. The body was recovered by subsequent dragging operations. SRDI participated over six days.

SUN 28 OCT CALL 1.078 20 people 68 hours R38

Two young women went for a day hike on Saturday and did not return. The male friend of one of them reported them overdue, but did not remember where they intended to go. One car was found at the Finger Rock Trailhead, and the other was not known. The information suggested that they were headed east towards Sabino, so trails were covered over to West Fork Sabino. At the end of their search, Ranger 38 looked along the Pima Canyon Trail and spotted the two several miles up canyon. Teams met them soon afterwards. They intended to hike down Finger Rock, but may have only reached the head of Pima Canyon before nightfall.
