Summit Hut repaired four damaged Rescucenders without charge and donated a fifth Rescucender to SARA.

Jim Gilbreath desires all SARA groups, which conduct training - Helo Rappel, ATTP, Urban, etc. - to report to the Training Committee in order to form a master training list.

The criteria for experienced rescuers to join SARA - Policy for Reinstatement of Former Members and Policy for Acceptance of Members of Other Teams - is available for membership comment. The document is posted in the SARA House "Chandelier Room.' Please make comment to Scott Clemans, Jim Gilbreath, or any SARA board member.

Basic IV will be on Super Bowl Saturday, January 25, 2003.

With a new candidate class approaching Linda Catterson will begin advertising with local outdoor entities. The applicant meeting will be February 11, and the candidate hike in the following Saturday, February 15.

SARA's MRA Snow Rescue Certification is now slated for February 8. Rich Kunz, Dave Brown, Scott Clemans, and Mykle Raymond were picked as SARA evaluators. We are looking at lodging the visitors at the Sheraton Tucson with a post-certification barbecue at SARA House. More details will come following the MRA Winter Meeting next month in Salt Lake City.

2.094 021207 Sat 14 23 2m hikers overdue Sabino Canyon, Catalinas

Two hikers were overdue while hiking from Marshall Gulch to the Sabino Canyon Visitors Center. Ranger 38 spotted their lights a short distance up the trail, and T.J. escorted the tired hikers to the end of the road.

2.095 021209 Mon 6 62ym hiker separated Pima Canyon Trail, Catalinas

A group of hikers missed the Pima Canyon Trail at the top of Mt. Kimball, and were an hour into Pima Canyon before they figured out that they weren't going to find the Finger Rock Trail without returning to the top of the mountain. One of the group was well ahead, but they were in contact by FRS radios. He chose to continue down the strange trail while the others figured out how to find the Finger Rock Trail, and called by cellphone to seek guidance concerning their companion. We sent a team up the Pima Canyon Trail, meeting the separated hiker soon after the first crossing. He had followed the trail very nicely, and very quickly without problems.

2.096 021210 Tue 13 90 ??ym hiker, exhausted knee Ventana Canyon, Catalinas

Two people hiked up Ventana Canyon to the Window, and thought that continuing on the same trail might provide a more convenient and quicker route back. They called by cellphone for guidance, and learned that the way they were headed would be a longer way out via Esperero Canyon. So they chose to return by the way they had come. At 17:00 they were around Maiden Pools, and having problems with a very tired knee, and they were out of water, and they had no lights. We met them above the pools a couple of hours later. He was able to move very slowly, but warmed enough after twenty minutes that he could move steadily down canyon, and all were out of the field soon after midnight.

2.097 021214 Sat 16 63 62yf hiker exhausted Wilderness of Rocks, Catalinas

A 62yf and her two sons hiked from Marshall Gulch into the Wilderness of Rocks, then up to the Lookout. Not knowing of any alternative routes to use for their return, they retraced their steps. She was pretty tired by the time it got dark, so they called for help. The first team met the group just after Marshall Saddle as they continued to move slowly. After a short rest, they continued down trail until running into a couple of mules. She rode most of the remainder of the trail. One of her sons was moving pretty slowly by the time they got out.
