

#### **HAM Repeater Status**

The Aspen Fire has burned almost all radio installations on Radio Ridge, east of the pavement. This includes our ham shack adjacent to the top of the Ski Lift. None of the structures or equipment are salvageable.

We will be using the RACES 448.550 repeater as we did during the Bullock Fire. The site housing the RACES repeaters is being replaced, so the antennas are currently mounted on top of the county building. The coverage is less extensive, maybe into the fall, maybe later.

An alternative repeater is the Tucson Mountains 447.875 at KB7RFI, especially for work on the west end of the Catalinas.

Both of these repeaters are listed on the SARCI web site, and are usually included in basic radio programming.

Please remember that these repeaters are used for other purposes and by other people.

A group hiked up Pontatoc Canyon to the Amphitheater. One of the women was having cardiac problems. Rescue teams met the group near the base of the switchbacks. The old tent platform was cleared for Ranger to land, and they ferried her to the ambulance at basecamp.

#### 3.026 030426 Sat 15 19 37ym hiker missing Sycamore Basin, Catalinas

A group last saw one of their companions in Sycamore Basin. Although the group had talked about the Palisades Trail, they chose to return to the Prison Camp. Shortly after the search started from many trailheads, the missing hiker returned to their vehicles, having gone up the Palisades Trail on his own.

#### 3.027 030430 Wed 19 64 63yf distraught missing Downtown Tucson

R38 TPD P&R

A distraught woman left an office in downtown Tucson. Search teams worked along the tracks, Santa Cruz River, around "A" Mountain, and along drainages, letting people know of the search. A number of people from the woman's church also searched. TPD detectives took the search from there. She apparently called home at 02:30 the next morning and asked her husband to pick her up along the frontage road near  $22^{\text{nd}}$  St.

## 3.028 030503 Sat 5 26 Evidence Search Box Canyon, Santa Ritas

Canine and Horse teams looked along the west end of Box Canyon for victims of a Biker altercation, and found nothing.

#### 3.029 030504 Sun 15 30 45yf hiker fall victim Soldier's Canyon, MP 0.5, Catalinas RMFD

A female climber rolled down a rock while hiking back to the highway after a climb. She refused treatment by medics for back pain and a head laceration, but accepted a litter carry for the short distance back to the vehicles. Her companion drove her to the ER.

#### none 030515 Thu 0 0 16yf hiker overdue Pima Canyon, Catalinas

A 16y female started about 12:00 to hike up Finger Rock to Mt Kimball. She called her home at 16:00 from near the peak, saying that she was having problems finding the trail down Pima Canyon, was about out of water, and was not equipped for travel after dark. As search people were enroute, her mother called from the first crossing, 1 mile from trailhead. TJ and her father walked in to meet the pair as it got dark and the moon was in eclipse.
