

HAM Repeater Status

We will continue using the RACES 448.550 repeater as we did during the Bullock Fire. The site housing the RACES repeaters is being replaced, so the antennas are currently mounted on top of the county building. The coverage is less extensive, maybe into the fall, maybe later.

An alternative repeater is the Tucson Mountains 445.875 at KB7RFI, especially for work on the west end of the Catalinas. Both of these repeaters are listed on the SARCI web site, and are usually included in basic radio programming. Please remember that these repeaters are used for other purposes and by other people.

One UDA made it out of the desert and returned to Mexico. He reported separating from his companions, and another male returned to the border to report them missing. He was familiar with the route (smuggling cargo, not people), and one male was quickly found, code 900. Another six were supposed to be nearby. Several hours of searching by several resources did not find anyone else. The Growler Valley is west of Ajo about 10 miles, temps over 110 degrees, and a vehicle that wouldn't shift to 4WD.

3.037 030715 Tue 16 104 Search for ill UDA's west of Silverbell

PCSD, Pinal SD, USBP

One UDA made it out of the desert (sound familiar?) and reported that his companions were ill. Two were found quickly by helicopter, south of Friendly Corners, near Arizona Farms where we've been before. While recovering those two, another was reported at a well several miles away in poor condition. He wasn't that bad, but insisted he was alone until the original person showed up and greeted him enthusiastically. Gradually a tale of several more people was told, a couple of them having passed away that morning, and contact was lost with the others. It's hard to find people who want help, but don't want to be found.
