Survey-1, RMFD

A hiker called for help by cellphone, stating that he had hiked up La Milagrosa Canyon, and on the way back lost his balance, banging his body in several places. He had continued to hobble down canyon before calling for help. Two canyons are parallel to each other in this area, and easily confused. Survey-1 could see the hiker's flashlight and provided coordinates that indicated he was really in Agua Caliente Canyon. Teams arrived and determined that he needed to be carried by litter, with C-spine precautions. Meanwhile it started to rain, but it didn't last long. Several hours were required to muscle the litter down the canyon bottom filled with boulders, with a short trail very well appreciated at the bottom.

A vehicle drove into a flooded wash, the driver was observed to have exited and was carried downstream. Ranger 38 covered the area without finding anyone. As we arrived, they noticed some clothing that appeared to be associated with a body. It wasn't far from the road, so we were able to investigate quickly, finding only old clothing. The original call turned out to be associated with a Border Patrol attempt to stop a couple of vehicles observed dropping off undocumented migrants, then fleeing. The first vehicle made it across the wash, but the second one was stuck in the sand, and the driver bailed. A resident on the other side described the subject floating downstream, but he got himself out of the wash, and fled. So all people were accounted for and we wound up nursing an ill SARA-2 back to town.

3.040 030825 Mon 12 36 Flooded area investigation Golder Ranch Rd & Lago del Oro GRFD, FWFD, Survey-1 Flood water in the Canada del Oro wash spread over the floodplain into structures. River Rescue teams from several agencies were assigned to check the residences to ensure that any occupants were safe and accounted for. The water level had receded, so travel was just muddy and sloppy.

#### 3.041 030828 Wed 17 44 53ym missing

Sandario & Snyder Hill

Ranger38, SAV

He walked one of his granddaughters to the bus stop to meet another granddaughter, but tired halfway there and stopped to wait for the two to return. They didn't find him. He was reported missing at 01:00, and SAR people were requested at 08:00. As we were getting into the field, a resident called to report a subject needing help. Ranger38 found him 3.5mi from his residence, dehydrated, and transported him. Meanwhile, a woman arrived at basecamp reporting her husband missing while walking their child to the bus stop. SAV called the school, who wouldn't release any information about the child. The mother finally got to talk to her kid, who reported that dad had got into another vehicle at the bus stop. Nothing more for us to do.
