A hiker tripped on the trail, and was unable to walk. Park rangers met the hiker about 2.5 miles up trail, after dark. VIP horse riders (Posse) were requested, and SAR was asked to be on standby for a carry out, meeting in a parking lot outside of the park. The hiker was becoming cold, however he was able to move with help, and soon warmed with the exercise. When the group met the horses, he rode the remaining distance.

3.053 031124 15 26 1S 53ym hiker overdue Pima Canyon, Catalinas

OVPD

A hiker was dropped off at the north end of Alvernon, expecting to climb Kimball and reach the east end of Magee by late afternoon. Given his time of departure, we determined that he was right on time, and should be a mile or two up trail. The hasty team met him at the first crossing, one mile from the trailhead, and all returned to the parking lot in good shape.

3.054 031129 11 11 4R ??ym ankle injury Safford Peak, Tucson Mtns

A male hiker injured his ankle while hiking on Safford Peak, at the north end of the Tucson Mountains, and called by cellphone for help. His exact location was vague, so we met at Orange Grove and Thornydale. Tucson Ranger was directed to the hiker by a relay from cellphone to radio, and landed a short distance from the hiker. He was assisted to the helicopter, and flown directly to Northwest Hospital.

3.055 031203 15 54 1S ??ym hikers disoriented Madera Canyon, Santa Rita Mtns R38 SCSO SCSAR

Two hikers from out-of-country called for help by cellphone. The poor connection provided only that they had parked in Madera Canyon, and were now on a road numbered "72", walking south. All attempts to call them were unsuccessful. We were guessing that there were more than one in the group, but it was uncertain how many there were. Santa Cruz SO established an IC near the lodge in Madera Canyon, since the trailhead is closed for reconstruction. One team was on trail, hiking to Josephine Saddle. Forest Road 72 was discovered to be the Temporal Gulch road, in the canyon east of the ridge running from Mt. Wrightson to Patagonia. One vehicle was assigned to drive up the road. Pima County SAR people responded to the IC, and teams started up each of the three trails leading to Josephine Saddle, expecting teams to reorganize as needed for additional assignments. Tucson Ranger started in Temporal Canyon, finding two subjects a short distance south of Walker Mine, then ensured that they were on the same road that the SAR vehicle was using. As teams returned to the IC, the hikers were met by the vehicle team.
