#### MT LEMMON HAM SHACK UPDATE

Work is progressing at the top of Mt Lemmon to revive the KA7SLW Ham Shack that was destroyed in the Aspen Fire. That shack housed, not only the two repeaters supporting Pima County Search and Rescue, but also a remote base site of the local Cactus Intertie affiliate, an APRS digipeater and weather station, a digipeater supporting digital packet communication by local Hams and a 6M repeater.

The new building is mostly complete and is almost ready to accept the new racks of equipment which are being built and tested down in the valley. The tower is being renovated, with all tower bolts, guys wires and grounds already replaced. Connection of the shack and tower to the underground grounding system is in progress.

Remaining tasks include installation of new feedlines up the tower, refurbishment or replacement of the antennae on the tower, completion of the grounding system, and installation and testing of the new equipment racks. We hope to have the shack back in operation within the next month or two.

There is still plenty of work to do, both on the tower and on the ground. If you would like to join in the fun, please let Mykle Raymond know and he will include you in the communications announcing the work party's.

#### June Monthly Training: Desert Travel and Survival Training

The classroom session for the summer desert travel and survival training will be Wednesday, June 2, 2004 at 18:30 at the SARA house. The outline for the class is:

- 1. Deserts of the Southwest.
- 2. Introduction to the Sonoran desert.
- 3. Discussion of the Sky Islands and life zones in the Sonoran desert.
- 4. Human physiology
- 5. Travel and existing in the desert.

The field exercise will be Saturday, June 5, 2004. Rendezvous will be at 11:00 am at Tanque Verde and Tanque Verde Loop at the Circle K. The field exercise will be at milepost 7.5 in Redington Pass. The outline for the field exercise is:

- 1. Mock rescue and hiking in the desert. The hike will be 2 miles and the location has been scouted.
- 2. Being seen and found in the desert. Set up a bivouac, shade shelter and signal to aircraft so you can be located for the air.
- 3. DPS Ranger will do a fly over to participate in the mock rescue and to see how visible your bivouac is from the air.
- 4. DPS ranger will set down and do a debriefing. DPS crew will do a static helicopter training in time permits.

This is the basic end of the exercise and folks hike out. Those that are willing will do an optional overnight at their bivouac location and hike out the next morning.
