One team continued following the track while a second team headed in from Gordon's Place (Prison Camp). As both teams approached the base of the Palisades Trail, the subject was located in good condition. All teams walked out Sabino.

Departed base camp at 18:30 on the Old Baldy Trail to Josephine saddle. Continued towards Baldy Saddle about one mile, stopping at a large log across trail. Waited an hour for patient to be carried from Baldy Saddle. Patient (female with injured knee) rode Dr. Dave's horse, with Terry Moore following closely on foot to help patient, and Larry led on mule. Started down about 21:00, arriving base camp at 23:00. Everyone was happy to put patient on horse as the mile they carried her made them all very tired.

Both hikers made it out under their own power, with assistance.
