7 Falls Trail, Bear Canyon

RMFD, R42

Four people hiked up Bear Canyon. One went ahead to 7 Falls, then returned without seeing her companions. The remaining three had gone up the canyon bottom, then turned around before reaching the falls. One became ill, so he was left by water while the other two went for help. One of them collapsed about the first crossing. While treating him, rescue people were told more about the male that had been left upstream. Teams covered to the falls, and Ranger searched well upstream without results. Continued discussions with the remaining party suggested that he would be below and not above the falls. Teams had no voice contact, but the helicopter must have awoken him, and he began to respond to shouts. He was about 400 feet above the stream. Rescue people assisted him down the slope on belay, then across the stream and over to the trail, and gave him a stokes ride to the road. Psychological problems combined with exhaustion to make the investigation interesting.
