In addition to SAR services, 1SRG offers international training and program development in an effort to reduce the need for international response by enabling local resources to successfully manage their own SAR events. 1SRG has successfully deployed to places such as Fiji, Mexico, Peru, and Tajikistan using members drawn from teams much like SARA. 1SRG is an associate member of the MRA.
