

18:44 – 02:30 Hunters reported finding remains in a remote area, in the Tumacacori Mtns east of Arivaca, near a dirt road about seven miles from Arivaca Road. The area was searched for several hours during the night, without success. TJ searched the area again in the morning, without success. A couple of days later, another report was received, a couple miles downstream, and Deputy Steve was able to drive to the scene to investigate and make the recovery.

# 5.030 050510 Tue 9 10 ??ym hiker overdue MP12, Arizona Trail, Redington Pass

13:29 – 14:37 A solo hiker was dropped off on the Arizona Trail, where it crosses Redington Road at the junction with the road to Italian Trap. He was due to be picked up several days later, the morning of a day that he had a final exam at school. He was picked up by a searcher driving up the road, apparently after hiking down Tanque Verde Canyon.

## 5.031 050515 Sun 17 51 45yf hiker exhausted Phoneline Tr, Sabino Canyon, Catalinas RMFD USFS

15:38 – 17:05 – 19:28 A hiker stationed at Ft. Huachuca took his mother for a tram ride up Sabino Canyon, then hiked down the Phoneline Trail. She is from New York City, originally from Russia, understands but does not speak much English, and is not used to hiking, the heat, or steep slopes. She also has a history of several medical issues, so when she tired her anxiety rose and her progress down trail stopped about a quarter mile up canyon from the Phoneline Link Junction. She rode the stokes down to Tram Stop 1 at the foot of the Phoneline Link Trail.

# 5.032 050520 Fri 0 0 36yf hiker missing Romero Pools, Romero Canyon, Catalinas

16:02-16:15 A 36yf hiker was last seen about 09:30 near Romero Pools. Shortly after volunteers were paged, a deputy reported meeting her on trail a short distance from the old trailhead.
