08:52 – 11:44 Divers assisted with evidence search and recovery of drowning victim in an irrigation canal.

5.033 050529 Sun 8 32 UDA recoveries W Elephant Head Rd & Arivaca Rd

10:00 - 14:20 One set of remains was recovered without our assistance, the second was carried about a half-mile to a rough road, while Border Patrol was processing a group of a dozen UDA at base camp.

5.034 050530 Mon15 31 18ym hiker ankle injury 7 Falls Tr, Bear Canyon, Catalinas

12:03 - 14:31 A male jumped into a pool at 7 Falls, injuring his ankle while attempting to impress a female. A physician on scene taped the ankle and assisted him down trail until met by rescue people, downstream from the last crossing. He rode a horse the rest of the way to the old trailhead.

5.035 050601 Wed 5 15 UDA recovery Green Valley USBP

20:47 – 24:00 Recovery of UDA remains, in a desert area south of Green Valley.

5.036 050602 Thu 13 73 UDA recoveries Green Valley & Arivaca USBP

16:52 – 01:00 A litter was provided to USBP for recovery of one UDA by ATV south of Green Valley. The second UDA was recovered about 10 miles of rough roads, south of Arivaca.

5.037 050616 Thu 4 7 Hikers off trail Butterfly Trail, Catalinas

16:30-18:45 Two hikers were off trail near the Crystal Springs Trail junction. They continued to search for the trail, found it, and met the first SAR people to arrive at the trailhead.

5.038 050618 Sat 6 26 Hiker exhausted Picacho Peak Ranger54, AVFD, PPstPk

14:33 – 18:30 A 230lb+ hiker was heat exhausted on the west side of Picacho Peak. Tucson Ranger requested assistance by our helirappel team. One rescuer rappelled to the scene and packaged the patient for a short-haul, with the assistance of park and meds people.

5.039 050626 Sun 18 248 Swimmer drowned Patagonia Lake Cochise, SantaCruz divers
06:00 - 18:00 Cochise, Santa Cruz and Pima County divers searched Patagonia Lake off the swimming beach for a missing

5.040 050627 Mon 9 75 Swimmer drowned Patagonia Lake SantaCruz divers

04:30 – 14:00 Continuation of search for missing swimmer. The subject was located at 11:30.

5.041 050703 Sun 0 0 40ym hiker disoriented

Mt Bigelow, Catalinas

10:06 – 10:17 A 40ym hiker came up the Butterfly Trail from Palisades and lost the trail, winding up on the east slope below Mt. Bigelow. He spent the night on the slope, and campers heard his cries for help in the morning. They determined that he was not injured, then one of the campers worked his way down the slope to the subject, then assisted him back up to the road. SAR people were cancelled while enroute.

5.042 050703 Sun 11 33 47ym hiker overdue

Green Mtn Trail, Catalinas

20:00-23:50 A male hiker lost the Green Mountain Trail and was stranded by dark. Search teams found him a couple miles from the trailhead and walked him out without problems.

5.043 050704 Mon 15 68 Fall victim

Catalina Hwy, MP13, Catalinas

MLFD, TucsonRanger

20:18 – 01:35 A 30 year old male lost his footing while climbing around the rocks near Punch & Judy. Ranger thought the subject may have been alive, but the movement they saw was probably shifting shadows. Mt Lemmon Fire people rappelled down the slope, followed by rescue people, confirming the subject was deceased. He had lodged in rocks about 120' down, and well above the base of the cliffs. Rescue people packaged and secured him in place, then planned to return in the morning to complete the recovery. The slopes are looser after the highway construction, presenting more of a safety hazard.

05:10-10:40 Continuation of the body recovery near Punch & Judy. The subject was lowered to the base of the cliffs, then Ranger short-hauled him to the road below.

09:38 – 13:45 A hiker injured her ankle in Ventana Canyon. The Posse rode her most of the way down trail, then switched to a stokes ride for a short distance after she felt poorly.
