5.071	050929 Thu	9 10	85ym hiker exhausted 12:24 – 13:29 An 85ym hiker became exhausted on a hot day, just before the first crossing (1.0 miles). Two deputies provided water and assisted the hiker back to the trailhead. Rescue people met the group near the Forest Boundary.	Pima Canyon, Catalinas	PCSD, RMFD
5.072	051010 Mon	6 6	3 climbers overdue 12:35 – 13:27 Three climbers were overdue from a climb of the Southeast Arete. They completed the climb and were starting down at dark and made camp with minimal supplies, then walked out in the morning. Tohono O'Odham personnel met them at the trailhead, and Deputy Steve met them near the highway while rescue people were arriving at rendezvous.	Baboquivari Peak	TOPD, TucsonRanger
5.073	051016 Sun	13 81	2 hikers stranded 06:03 – 12:56 Two hikers climbed the peak on the northwest side, then thought the north side would be an easier descent. When they became stranded between cliffs, they called for help by cellphone. Saguaro Park rangers asked Tucson Ranger for help. The helicopter was unable to retrieve the pair, but dropped supplies to make the night a little less of a problem. In the morning, SAR teams climbed to a point above the pair, while the helicopter inserted a rescuer nearby. When the hikers were prepared and in position, the helicopter returned and ferried them to the base.	Safford Peak, Tucson Mtns	NPS, TucsonRanger
5.074	051021 Fri	7 16	44ym hiker lost 20:51 - 23:30 A hiker from Philadelphia was unable to find the Finger Rock Trail after reaching the peak, and wound up in Pima Canyon (sound familiar?). He called for help by cellphone, but could not be reached by return call (he moved down trail). His rental vehicle was found at the trailhead, and a team headed up trail. A second team started up Pima Canyon, finding the hiker before the team reached the Forest Boundary.	Mt. Kimball, Catalinas	TucsonRanger
