In order to reduce undesirable email traffic, our list servers employ some basic filters. These guidelines are offered to help folks compose email messages that are courteous and won't get stuck in these SPAM filters:

1) Keep the address list down to 10 or less.

2) Do not address any list servers as a "Blind Copy".

3) Keep attachments small and few. Check with each recipient before sending messages larger than a couple hundred kilobytes in size.

4) Be aware of how many copies folks will see. There is substantial overlap on many of the lists. It would not be appropriate to hit one individual with 4, 5 or even 6 copies of a single message. An index of "List server Members" has been posted on the SAR Data page so anyone can tell who-is-on-what-list.

### TECHNICAL COMMITTEE MEETING SUMMARY

The following is a summary of the recent technical committee meeting. Please ask if you have questions or would like a copy of the full summary.

General Notes:

- The upcoming Basic Instructors meetings will cover Basic III training.
- Recommended holding a review session prior to each recert.
- At recert, provide enough haul system stations to accommodate the number of people being recertified.
- Chaining of webbing is fine in personal gear, not in tech kits. Rolling is more compact, easier to pass through a ratchet knot for litter tie-in, easier to identify by length, and provides padding in packs.
- Overhand and Barrel knots are acceptable safety knots.

Updates to documentation (before changing training or recert):

- Each of the four types of anchors needs to be demonstrated at recert.
- Revise tensionless anchor to require minimum slack and loose end tied down.
- Add Haul-in-a-bag to manual.
- Miscellaneous updates and tweaks to manual.

The body of a UDA was being investigated by PCSD, and requested assistance to transport the remains to a road 13:47 - 14:46some distance from the scene. While personnel were enroute, the officers found a nearby road and were able to recover the remains.

#### 5.084 051128 Mon 9 13 Hikers disoriented Finger Rock Tr, Catalinas

19:32 - Two hikers returning from Mt Kimball at dusk without lights were not able to find the trail on the other side of a stream crossing below the spring and called for assistance. They were found on trail above the spring and escorted to the trailhead.

#### 5.085 051207 Wed 5 5 9ym autistic missing

Catalina State Park, Catalinas CSP, TucsonRanger 17:45 - 18:33A 9ym autistic finished a trail ride with his mother, then they walked down a trail until she was not able to keep up with the boy and called for assistance. He was in good condition and walked down the old road along the Canada del Oro wash to the Equestrian Center in the park, where he was found by searchers as SAR people were arriving at the park.

5.086 051212 Mon 12 33 22yf hiker collapsed **Douglas Spring Trail, Rincons** A 22yf was hiking with a companion on the Douglas Spring Trail. She stopped to rest at the top of a steep section, 10:24 - 13:14 then collapsed. Her friend called for help. Several minutes later, a pair of hikers arrived and assisted with CPR. Rural Fire arrived, expecting the patient to be at the trailhead. Dan was preparing for a ride, and started up trail to find the patient. Meanwhile, responders were told that the scene was 45 minutes up trail. Dan arrived on scene 1.3 miles up trail and assisted finding a spot for Lifeline to land. Their medical people were working on the patient as additional SAR teams arrived. She was carried by litter a couple hundred yards up trail to the helicopter, then flown to the trailhead where she was declared deceased.
