Still looking for new qualified Posse members. Have inquires referred over to Greg as listed above.



Hands-on experience was obtained in the use of signal mirrors, construction of shade shelters and desert stills. The day was completed by the conduct of a search and then rescue of an "exhausted" hiker. Everyone gained a better appreciation for conducting a rescue mission on a 100 + degree day.

18:22 - 20:29Two teens missed the trail down from the top of Pusch Peak, and headed down to the north until cliffed out. They were out of water and the sun was low, so they called home for help. Ranger was busy in Charouleau Gap, so teams started up trail and up towards the saddle below the hikers. Ranger finished about dark, plucked the pair from the peak and quickly deposited them near the trailhead.

6.045 060614 Tue 12 45 78ym Alzheimers patient missing Dove Mountain, Marana

22:36 - 03:45A man was last seen walking thru his Dove Mountain neighborhood in the late afternoon. About dark he was reported missing, and SAR was requested several hours later. Canine teams looked thru the neighborhood, a tracking team looked along the edge of the desert. Teams secured without any sign. The subject was located a few hours later on one of the golf courses not far from home.

6.046 060617 Sat 13 44 48ym hiker exhausted Pima Canyon, Catalinas

13:54 - 19:13A hiker was returning from Pima Saddle when he felt weak. He had plenty of water, but had not had anything to eat during the day. SAR teams found him in the shade at the dam about three miles up canyon. After feeding and drinking, teams had a hard time keeping up with him. As this call was getting started, an exhausted person was reported at the end of the road in Sabino. It took awhile for Rural Fire to sort out while we were enroute, eventually finding an 8 year old person rather than the 80 year old person that was reported.
