

#### 6.095 21 Nov Tue 19 43 43ym climber fell Soldier's Canyon, Catalinas TucsonRanger, USFS, RMFD 15:27 - 18:20 A climber fell about 30', pulling his protection, and landing in the sand at the base of the climb. TucsonRanger found a place to land short distance downstream.

6.096 02 Dec Sat 12 27 2 hikers off trail Wilderness of Rocks, Catalinas **TucsonRanger** Two hikers called for help after getting off trail near the top of Mt. Lemmon. They continued up the slope as teams 17:48 - 19:33headed up hill, meeting the pair on the road a short distance from the top.

#### 6.097 27 Dec Tue 20 81 Grandmother + kids lost Sycamore Reservoir, Catalinas **TucsonRanger** A grandmother and three kids took a wrong turn while returning to their group in Soldiers Canyon. Teams covered 18:00 - 22:50

Soldier's Canyon and trail, and down to Sycamore Reservoir where they were found just before cold rain began. All were walked and carried back to Gordon's Place (Gordon Hirabayashi Recreation Site).

## 6.098 27 Dec Tue 11 31 Three hikers stranded by dark Sabino Canyon, Catalinas

22:50 - 01:30As the previous call was finishing, three hikers were reported stranded by dark in Sabino Canyon. They had started that morning from a residence south of Bear Canyon, and were hiking to Sycamore Basin and down Sabino. It sounded like they were near Pine Creek Crossing. Teams heading up Sabino located them around a fire a short distance above the switchbacks and hiked them out without problems.

0 0 ??ym hiker overdue 6.099 30 Dec Sat Ventana Canyon, Catalinas 19:35 - 19:48 A hiker was overdue on a hike to the Window. He returned before anyone arrived at the trailhead.

7.001 02 Jan Tue 13 69 3m, 1f stranded by cliffs Finger Rock Canyon, Catalinas **TucsonRanger** 18:40 – Three teens were stranded by dark and cliffs below The Finger. TucsonRanger spotted their fire and provided coordinates. They were relatively low in the canyon, and we have worked in that area several times including recently, so the group was retrieved without complications.

7.002 08 Jan Mon 10 17 ??ym injured Cactus Picnic Area, Catalinas USFS, RMFD 16:23 - 17:35A injured male was found by a hunter near the old picnic area in Sabino Canyon. He was quickly packaged and carried back to the road.

TucsonRanger, PCSO 7.003 11 Jan Thu 17 27 ??ym alzheimers missing McDonald Park, Tucson An elderly male wandered from his family at McDonald Park on Harrison. Patrol cars covered the neighborhood, 19:51 - 21:00and several teams began to cover fencelines and washes. A SAR volunteer arriving at the park reported seeing a person along the road that matched the description, and he was retrieved in good condition.

7.004 14 Jan Sun 17 40 ??ym hiker leg injury Douglas Spring Trail, Rincons TucsonRanger, NPS, RMF A hiker pulled a muscle about five miles up trail and called for help. While many people with equipment were 14:02 - 16:36 heading up trail, TucsonRanger responded to see if they could at least spot the subject. They did, and found a place to land. The patient was splinted while Ranger moved to a closer spot, then flew two people to the trailhead.
