24 HOURS IN THE OLD PUEBLO - REVIEW

SARCI members did an outstanding job providing medical and communications support at the 24 Hours in the Old Pueblo mountain bike race at Willow Springs Ranch on 16-17 February 2008. A brief report of participation follows.

Medical Support:

A total of 19 volunteers were specifically dedicated to medical support throughout the weekend. These members and candidates worked a total of 377 hours over that period.

Friday: 8 volunteers, 52 hours Saturday: 17 volunteers, 141 hours Sunday: 15 volunteers, 184 hours

During that time a total of 29 participants, spectators and volunteers were treated. The injuries included a broken clavicle, a likely concussion, and numerous cases of road rash, cactus impalements, and several lacerations requiring suturing as well as evaluating one patient in respiratory distress. There were no injuries that warranted a SARA-supervised evacuation, either by air or ground. There were several cases where people self-evacuated or were driven to a hospital by a member of their team. There was one instance we know of where the team went directly to the hospital and not to the aid station.

Communications:

Total SARCI contribution to the communications net was 470 hours by 15 Volunteers (SRDI & SARA).

PROBABILITY OF DETECTION EXPERIMENT

Longtime SARA members will remember the experiments on probability of detection (POD) that SARA was involved with in the early 1980's.

On Saturday March 15th members of SARA have a rare opportunity to assist Professor David Lovelock in an experiment that will build on that experiment. This is an excellent opportunity to improve our search methods and our ability to calculate probability of detection in the Sonoran Desert environment. Professor Lovelock's colleagues from England will be in Tucson for this experiment. We will have an open house for them at the SARA house on Friday, March 14. This will be an excellent opportunity to learn about SAR in Great Britain. Details TBA.


Cave Rescue Classroom Training

8.005 Sun, 20 Jan24Ultralight missingGreen Valley areaCAP, TucsonRanger08:47 - 11:27An ultralight aircraft was missing.While we were on standby, the crash site was located by TucsonRanger.				
8.006 Sun, 20 Jan14 33Ill hikerMt Lemmon Trail, CatalinasTucsonRanger14:50 – 15:58An ill hiker was reported near Romero Pass.They were transported by helicopter to Catalina State Park.				
8.007 Tue, 22 Jan 7 40 3 boys overdue Sabino to Mt Lemmon, Catalinas 00:56 - Three ill equipped boys intended to hike up the mountain. Teams headed down three trails, expecting the boys to have been stranded by dark. The top of the mountain was cleared without finding them.				
8.008 Tue, 22 Jan17 100 3 boys overdueSabino to Mt Lemmon, CatalinasPhoenixRanger07:03 – 14:56Continuation of search. Tracks and a warm campfire were found in Romero Pass, tracks were found heading up by a team lower in Sabino, and the boys were found in good condition near Hutchs' Pool. All walked out down Sabino.				
8.009 Fri, 25 Jan 6 32 5yf UDA missing Miller Canyon, Huachucas BORSAR, CCSO, TucsonRanger 06:03 – 10:01 A group of UDAs were picked up by Border Patrol in Miller Canyon. The father of a 5y girl finally reported that she was missing, last seen with the guide who had evaded capture. BORSAR heard her crying, and found her in good condition soon after our teams got into the field.				
8.010 Thu, 31 Jan 10 38 68ym hiker overdueRomero Canyon, CatalinasTucsonRanger21:54 - A hiker from Chicago was returning down the Romero Trail, lost the trail and continued downstream. He didn't have a flashlight and was ill equipped for being out overnight. His cellphone was believed to be low on power, but we hoped that he would think of turning it on as a light source for the helicopter to spot. That worked, and he was found downstream of the waterfall in the "S"-bend. Teams dropped off the trail above and retrieved him while dealing with the loud stream noise.				
8.011 Fri, 01 Feb11 4217ym fall victimSki Valley, CatalinasMLFD, RMFD16:59 - 20:49A 17y male slid down the steep slope covered with hard snow/ice on the north side of the parking lot. He was not injured, but could not get back up the 400' slope. He wound up being hauled up in a litter, then miscellaneous gear was retrieved from the bottom of the slope.				
8.012 Tue, 19 Feb00Evidence searchGolf Links & Kolb, TucsonTPD14:48 – 18:46Cadaver dogs were requested by TPD.Nothing found.No documentation.TPD				
8.013 Thu, 21 Feb 10 16 3 teen girls off trail Mt Kimball, Catalinas TucsonRanger 15:51 – 17:48 Three girls hiked up Kimball and lost the trail soon after starting down. Teams headed up Pima and Finger Rock, then TucsonRanger spotted them (almost back on trail) a short distance below the saddle at the head of Finger Rock Canyon. They were retrieved and dropped off at the trailhead.
