The tow-truck cable was ferried to the scene and attached. All divers and stolen vehicle were soon out of the water. 9 Female hiker off trail Crystal Springs Trail, Catalinas 8.021 Tue, 01 Apr 3 13:08 - 17:28A hiker called for help after losing the trail. Coordinates from her cellphone plotted near the trail, below Butterfly Peak. A team found her without difficulty and all hiked out to the Soldier's Camp Trailhead. 8.022 Tue, 01 Apr 13 34 26ym autistic missing Gordon Hirabayashi Rec Area, Catalinas 14:53 - 17:28A group of young autistic people regularly go for a short hike and return for a picnic. One of them was reported missing. Initially the reports were that the PLS was at the picnic site, however the hikers turn-around point was more likely. Teams looked around the area, along the Soldier's Trail and canyon, and along the trail to Sycamore Reservoir. The missing person was not verbal. He was spotted after several teams had passed him, and another team was looking more carefully. He was fine. 8.023 Tue, 08 Apr 8 14 ??ym bicyclist shoulder injury Trail/Road to Chivo Falls **TucsonRanger** 18:01 - 19:27 A bicyclist crashed, and was unable to walk or ride with a shoulder injury. TucsonRanger located the scene, packaged and transported the patient. 8.024 Tue, 08 Apr 10 26 ??yf hiker stranded by dark Finger Rock Trail, Catalinas **TucsonRanger** 19:53 - 22:50 A hiker was moving more slowly than her companion, and was stranded after sunset. Teams met her below the overlook in good condition, and all hiked out without problems. 8.025 Thu, 10 Apr 6 7 Loose Horses Broadway & Freeman, Tucson 16:17 - 17:23 Horses were loose in a rural area, and Posse was asked to help. They were quickly rounded up. 8.026 Fri, 11 Apr 0 0 Rescue Tubac **TucsonRanger** 14:47 – 15:19Tucson Ranger requested assistance with an injured person in the Tubac area. We were canceled before arriving. 8.027 Fri, 11 Apr 12 16 ??yf hiker ankle injury **Butterfly Trail, Catalinas MLFD** A female hiker injured her ankle on the Butterfly Trail. Mt.Lemmon Fire made contact a short distance from the 17:27 - 18:25trailhead, and assisted her out. 8.028 Sat, 12 Apr 7 27 ??ym hiker overdue Finger Rock Trail, Catalinas **TucsonRanger** 17:20 - An out-of-town hiker called a friend and reported not being able to find the trail. Later he called again, having found the trail and heading down. TucsonRanger found a hiker matching the description about three miles up, and a team headed up to verify. It wasn't. We were not able to make cellphone contact, so weren't sure of his itinerary, and teams were checking Finger Rock and Pontatoc. Ranger checked the area again, in the day and after dark without any success. The team in Finger Rock made voice contact above the Overlook. Montrose Canyon, Catalinas Three hikers on the Canyon Loop reached Montrose Pools and continued upstream. As the sun set, they headed up 20:20 - 23:00 the north side of the canvon. It got dark and they called for help. Teams headed up trail as the helicopter arrived and located the party not far from the first saddle. A rescuer was dropped off nearby, and the hikers were rounded up, tended to, and prepared for being
