

Two BORSAR were dropped off on a ridge and made their way to her, joined soon by the team coming down canyon, and by another from Windy Point. All climbed to the helicopter and flew to Geology Vista.

Their description of their location was vague, but TucsonRanger spotted them, then dropped water while teams headed in from the east. All hiked out down the old trail.
