8.080 Sat. 18 Oct 10 36 2 20vm hikers off trail Pima Canvon Trail, Catalinas 16:10 - 21:00Two hikers went up Finger Rock Trail and reported problems finding the trail down Pima. Teams found the two in the streambed below the first dam. All walked out without problems.

9 ??vf hiker exhausted 8.081 Sun, 19 Oct 9 Sabino Canyon Trail, Catalinas

A group of hikers reported one of them was exhausted, and two went ahead for help. She had rested and been able 16:39 - 16:57 to continue, reaching the end of the road as rescue people arrived.

8.082 Sun, 26 Oct 16 54 80yf hiker ankle injury 7 Falls Trail, Catalinas **RMFD** A hiker injured her ankle near crossing 7, was treated and carried down to the Posse, and rode out without problems. 13:28 - 17:30

8.083 Tue, 28 Oct 11 22 ??ym hiker off trail

17:06 - 19:04A hiker followed Mt Lemmon and Wilderness of Rocks Trails, and became exhausted coming up Lemmon Rock. then ran out of daylight. He was near the top and quickly retrieved without problems.

8.084 Sun, 02 Nov 7 19 30yf 33ym hikers benighted Aspen Trail, Catalinas

17:57 - 20:40Two hikers (and dog) ran out of daylight on Aspen Trail. Voice contact was made from Radio Ridge, and a team met them on Black Dog Ridge. All hiked down Carter Canyon without problems.

8.085 Sun. 02 Nov 10 37 5 hikers stranded by dark 7 Cataracts, Willow Canyon, Catalinas As the previous call was concluding, a group of hikers reported themselves stranded by dark while coming down 19:10 - 23:00Willow Canyon. Teams responding to the top stopped at 7 Cataracts and made voice contact. Teams met them near the bottom and escorted them out without problems.

8.086 Sat, 08 Nov 10 33 27ym hiker exhausted Lemmon Rock Lookout Tr, Catalinas 21:11 - 01:00 A hiker on the Mt Lemmon, W.O.R., and Lemmon Rock loop became exhausted. He was met a short ways from the top and walked out, slowly.

8.087 Tue, 11 Nov 13 58 22ym hiker missing **Romero Pools, Catalinas** A male was dropped off at the Romero Trailhead by a friend on Monday about noon. He did not state where he was 15:07 - 21:43going, or when he would return, or how he would get home, and he did not have any overnight gear. He had not appeared by noon Tuesday, and was reported missing. He had been to Romero Pools several times, and that was all we had to go on. Teams covered major trails and drainages at low elevations, then secured for the evening.

8.088 Wed, 12 Nov 14 85 22ym hiker missing Romero Pools, Catalinas

09:00 - 18:18 Continuation of search. Two teams were dropped by TucsonRanger at Romero Pass, heading down Romero and Sabino. Romero downstream of the pools, and several low trails were covered.

8.089 Thu, 13 Nov 14 69 22ym hiker missing Romero Pools, Catalinas

[21:38] – 13:41 Continuation of search. Teams covered low trails, and headed up Sutherland, and Montrose upstream of the pools. The subject was located in good condition in the bottom of Montrose, below the trail. He walked out with teams without problems.

8.090 Thu, 13 Nov 17 80 80yf hiker knee injury Bear Canyon Trail, Catalinas **RMFD**

14:11 – [16:02] – 19:42 As the search was concluding, a knee injury was reported on Bear Canyon Trail, a mile up trail from 7 Falls but still directly above the falls. She rode the stokes down to the Posse below x7, and the rest of the way on horse.

8.091 Fri, 14 Nov 12 41 56yf hiker ill 7 Falls Trail, Catalinas **TucsonRanger** 14:49 - 18:00 A hiker became ill while hiking back from the falls. She was found by Ranger just below the Posse turn-around, and landed in the stream below x7. She was carried to the helicopter for a direct ride to the hospital.

8.092 Fri, 14 Nov 7 25 2 hikers stranded by dark Pusch Peak, Catalinas

18:11 – 23:00 As the rescue was concluding (sound familiar?), a report was received from a pair of hikers stranded by dark while coming down the Pusch Peak Trail. Teams located them off trail just above the "corner", and were retrieved without problems.

8.093 Sun, 16 Nov 10 28 26yf hiker missing Incinerator Ridge, Catalinas Survey1

A hiker reported his companion missing at the top of Davis Spring Trail. Teams headed down Butterfly Trail, then 20:36 - 23:20 a deputy saw reflections from the top of a road cut, along the highway above Palisades. She had made it back up trail to the Bigelow towers, expecting an emergency phone, then headed down to the highway after dark. She was assisted off the cliff without problems.

8.094 Wed, 19 Nov 11 44 68ym hiker exhausted Finger Rock Trail, Catalinas **RMFD** 17:45 - 22:00A hike up Pima and down Finger Rock had been hard to stay on trail. He was below Linda Vista Saddle when his knees became exhausted and the sun set. His knee was wrapped, and with a couple of hiking poles continued down trail with teams.

FWFD, TucsonRanger 8.095 Fri. 21 Nov 9 16 ??yf injured Gates Pass, Tucson Mtns An injured woman found above Gates Pass had been lying there for at least 24hrs. She was short-hauled to the road. 16:51 - 18:12
