SARCI FIELD QUALIFICATIONS STANDARD

On 1/21/2009 Search And Rescue Council Inc (SARCI) adopted the following minimum Field Qualification standard:

Effective July 01, 2009, the SARCI Field Qualification minimum shall include:

- 1) SARCI Orientation and
- 2) Wilderness First Aid as certified by ASHI, or equivalent and
- 3) CPR for the Professional Rescuer as certified by ARC or AHA, or equivalent and
- 4) National Incident Management System (NIMS) IS-100 and IS-700, or equivalent.

This will replace older policies that cited courses which have not been available for many, many years.



14:38 – 18:31 A male became separated from his group, wandering into Willow Canyon. When found, he was having symptoms of prior cardiac problems. He was carried by stokes to the parking lot.

05:29 – 11:51 3 ATV riders reported being lost, having abandoned their vehicles. PCSD and BorderPatrol teams looked through the night, requesting additional vehicular resources in the morning. Teams of two vehicles (two people each) patrolled roads on all sides of the Sierritas. Additional clues were developed, focusing the search on the south side. TucsonRanger spotted the subjects and landed. Several other teams arrived shortly. One subject was flown to the hospital, the others were transported by ambulance.

"The Crack", Sabino Canyon, Catalinas RMFD

13:07 – 16:46 A male visiting Tucson walked up the road in Sabino Canyon with friends. Although he was complaining of being tired in the heat, his companions pressed on. He fainted at Stop 8 and water was poured over him and he sat in the shade before the group continued upstream to swim at "The Crack". RuralMetro and a deputy were unable to find the subject, but a tram driver confirmed that the subject had been at Stop 8. SAR people drove up the road, paying extra attention to areas near the stream, and the party was found upstream. Teams assessed the subject, and he wound up being carried by stokes to an ambulance called to Stop 8.
