Sat 05 Mar <u>6/</u> <u>6/</u> ??y? hiker ankle injury Molino Canyon Trail, Catalinas RMFD A hiker was reported to have injured an ankle a half-mile up trail. We were going to inspect the trail from the 13:48 - 13:58 highway that is parallel, and from the road up through the picnic area, but the patient was assisted by companions to the road.

Fri 11 Mar <u>18/ 54/</u> 54ym downs missing Catalina State Park, Catalinas A group had walked up a game/social trail for a picnic. After lunch, they looked for their missing companion before 14:40 - 18:25asking for help. It was felt that a person with Down's Syndrome would not be interested in exploring an unfamiliar area, but would sit and pull a favorite item out of his pack and concentrate on it. Initial reports of the point-last-seen were at the start of the social trail, and it took awhile to encourage the supervisor to escort a team to their picnic spot. A couple of teams were in the general area, and soon heard a voice that no one claimed to be responsible for. The subject was found in good condition near the PLS and walked out.

Northwest Tucson Sat 12 Mar 28/162/ Evidence Search 08:00 - 12:00 Several teams covered areas of interest without problems. Nice exercise for lots of people. Lunch was provided!

Sat 12 Mar 11/ 96/ ??ym hiker off trail Pima Canyon Trail, Catalinas

An out-of-town hiker reported himself off-trail and out of water. The initial impression was that he had missed the 16:11 - 01:30 junction near the top of Kimball, and would be high in Pima. Contact was lost, probably due to battery, but his phone was from out-ofcountry which complicated the problem. Teams started up Pima and Finger Rock Trails. Reports from other groups in Finger Rock described a person that seemed to match the subject having been seen on that trail. Survey 2 is a Sheriff's Dept aircraft with shorttakeoff-and-landing (STOL) and surveillance capabilities. These aircraft have become more useful as their capabilities increase. They looked around the Finger Rock team, then expanded their search, and reported finding a person attracting their attention. The reported coordinates were on-trail near the head of Pima Canyon, and the lead team was at the spring below. They met the hiker close to the coordinates and all walked out without problems. So, the person in Finger Rock wasn't him. And the new engine in Survey 2 is as distracting as a helicopter!

Wed 16 Mar Sierrita Mtns <u>03/</u> <u>03/</u> 52yf missing A woman was reported to be missing and off her medications. Initial coverage by family and officers didn't locate 14:55 - 15:37 her, so additional resources were requested. As volunteers were meeting, she was located on the side of a hill by family. We continued until they verified that no further assistance was needed.


