#### SARA MONTHLY TRAINING

The SARA Winter Skills training is upcoming. While we do not get called to operate in winter conditions more than a handful of times every couple of years, calls like the recent rescue near Marshall Peak illustrate why it is important for everyone to be well rehearsed in the basic techniques of winter operations. This training will be presented in two parts. First we will have a classroom session on Tuesday 31 January 2012, 19:00 at the SARA House. This classroom session is a mandatory component of the training. We expect the classroom session will last around 2 hours and will be an introduction to equipment and other considerations that facilitate safe operations in winter conditions.

The field portion of the training will be on Saturday 04 February 2012. Preliminary rendezvous will be 08:00 at PCSO Substation 106, Catalina Hwy and Tanque Verde. This could change depending on conditions on the mountain, expect a training page if a change occurs. The field session will consist of hands-on practice moving over snow and ice with snowshoes/crampons, making shelter/fire on snow, snow anchors, and methods to evacuate a patient over snow and ice. The training should be a lot of fun. Even if you have participated in previous years we encourage you to attend again.

Again we hope to see you all for this training (it is an Orange Card sign-off). Remember attendance at the classroom session is mandatory to participate in the field session, and we will only sign Orange Cards after the Saturday field session. In the meantime, let's hope for some more snow on the mountain!

As a look ahead, the March monthly training (on Saturday 03 March) will be Tanque Verde Falls Orientation.
