#### SARA HOUSE SCHEDULING

To prevent scheduling conflicts, the SARA Board of Directors has established the position of Master Scheduler. For the time being this position is being filled by Jason Bowman. Anyone planning an official SARA event (trainings, committee meetings, work parties, PR events, bike race support, etc.) or any event to be held at the SARA House (such as trainings or meetings of other SARCI groups) must go through the Master Scheduler. The Master Scheduler will confirm if that date is available and put the event on the calendar. Eventually the Master Calendar will be published on the SARCI website, but for now it is only viewable to committee heads who request the link until all the bugs are worked out.

#### SARCI COMMUNICATIONS

Attention all Group or Personal radio owners on "Rescue" or "MRA" Channels. Our radio licenses prohibit operation in "Wide Band" mode beginning January1<sup>st</sup>. By the end of the year all radios operating on these channels, including radios authorized under a "Personal Radio Permission Form", must be removed from service or verified to transmit only in "Narrow Band" mode. To assure compliance (and protect our licenses) the old "Personal Radio Permission Form" will expire and be void effective 11:59pm on 12/31/12. A replacement authorization form, available from <u>SARCIcomm @ sarci2.org</u> (and eventually from the SARCI data website), must be submitted and authorized before transmitting on Rescue or MRA channels.

Just to be clear: EACH AND EVERY RESCUE/MRA RADIO MUST BE INDIVIDUALLY AUTHORIZED BEFORE THEY CAN BE USED FOR TRANSMITTING IN 2013.

17:55 – 23:15 A parawing was launched from a hilltop well up Sutherland Canyon. While skimming the slopes, the pilot smashed an elbow against rocks, and crashed. A group of 4WD vehicles was coming down the powerline road, and assisted ferrying SAR people up the road, from where they could hike to the scene, assisted by a Customs helicopter providing directions from overhead. A Customs Blackhawk arrived and delivered additional equipment and a PJ, then short-hauled the patient to the trailhead.

#### Romero Pass, Catalinas

# Survey2

19:40-08:30 A dad was hiking with two kids from Catalina State Park to the top of Mt. Lemmon. They reached Romero Pass before running out of daylight and energy. A team hiked down from the top, replenished the group, then continued down Sabino. A team had delivered more supplies to the helispot above Hutchs' Pool. All made it out soon after dawn.

#### Sat 10 Nov 11/ 38/ Hikers exhausted

#### Lemmon Rock Trail, Catalinas

19:45-23:20 A large group of hikers went down Mt.Lemmon Trail, across Wilderness of Rocks, and were on their way up Lemmon Rock. The group wound up splitting in two, then one of the front group headed back to the other group but lost the trail in between. SAR teams found the groups well up the trail on a chilly evening, and retrieved the first group easily. The solo hiker was found and reunited with the second group, and all made it the rest of the way up, if a bit slowly.

#### Sat 23 Nov 14/ 105/ 52yf missing

### Mt Lemmon, Catalinas

08:00-18:20 A woman was reported missing from her residence in Oro Valley. The family found her vehicle at the trailhead on top of Mt.Lemmon, noting that she had wanted to watch the sunrise. Assuming that she would still be in the area, hasty teams covered the trails off the south side of Mt.Lemmon, and areas around the top of the mountain. Nothing relevant was found.

#### Mt Lemmon, Catalinas

#### Omaha 04P

08:00 -17:30 Continuation of search. Teams covered areas on top of Mt.Lemmon in more detail, and the top of the slope between the trailhead and around Lemmon Rock. Nothing relevant was found.

NOTE: She was found Tuesday by a SAR volunteer roaming on his own, below the Mt Lemmon Trail, east of the Meadow Trail Jct.

#### Tue 27 Nov 12/ 65/ 25ym stranded

#### 7 Falls, Bear Canyon, Catalinas

#### Survey 2

21:10 -02:45 A hiker reached 7 Falls, found no water, and continued up trail. He turned around, it got dark, he lost the trail and wound up in the canyon bottom, then decided to just head downstream. In the dark coming down 7 Falls, he lost his grip, fell and banged a hip, then fell head first into a pool. *Lucky guy*. Then his cellphone still worked. *Lucky guy*. Then he actually had service and coordinates were reasonable. *Lucky guy*. The hasty team had good contact with him as they approached, with teams getting near him from the trail above, and scrambling up the falls. One rescuer was lowered to him, then they found a route to scramble out with the help of a hand-line. All hiked out without problems. *Lucky guy indeed*.
