If you have questions regarding WFR-Pro, please email <u>wfrcoordinator @ sarci2.org</u>, which includes both the lead instructors and the coordinators.







He was complaining of pain in his neck and shoulders, and a wrist, and was very cold. The helicopter returned to the base with the companion, configured for a short-haul, then returned to the scene with another deputy to assist packaging the patient on an inclined slope. The patient was short-hauled to an ambulance, then Ranger returned to the scene to pick up the gear and remaining deputy. By that time, the Hasty Team had time to reach the scene (6 miles, 3500øclimb, in 2 hours 40 minutes). So they got a ride out too. Additional teams returned to the trailhead.
