For a fitness challenge in December, post a photo of yourself, wearing your full rescue pack and standing by the end-of-trail sign at the top of Blackett's Ridge. From the Sabino Visitor's Center, this is a round trip of about 6 miles with 1700' of elevation gain.

You can pass your photos using one of three methods:

- 1 Go to http://fawcetts.us/upload. Select browse, choose the file to upload and click upload. If you use this method, email sean @ fawcetts.us that you have uploaded a file.
- 2 Android users: install AndFTP. Setup to connect to Fawcetts.us server. Use sara for both username and password. Go to your gallery, select photo and share using AndFTP. If you use this method, email <u>sean @ fawcetts.us</u> that you have uploaded a file.
- 3 Email the photo to sean @ fawcetts.us.

SARA is still awaiting the fix on the NSP website so I can register our refreshers for this year.

NSP is working on the fix and they have been in contact with me. In the meantime, be sure to create your account and password so when I receive the go-ahead to register our refresher, you will have a short window to register the class. Once the window is closed my work begins.


Sheriff1
