SABINO CANYON PARKING

NEW TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

This is a reminder of some training requirements that will go into effect soon:

Bloodborne Pathogens Awareness training - needs to be done annually. Check your status on the SARCI Field Qual Report (available on the SARCI Data page) in the "BBP" column. It shows the year and month (YYMM) that your training expires.

If you need this training, contact your team leadership.

AZBasicSAR – must have been done after 2012. Check your status on the SARCI Field Qual Report in the "AZ Basic" Column. If this field is shaded yellow you must take a current version of this training.

If you need this 16 hour training, advise Records of your availability so we can schedule at appropriate times.

Sometime over the next few months these will formally become SARCI Field Qualification requirements. Don't delay!

At the June dry session, divers adjusted all BCD tank straps to facilitate mounting the pony bottles. The BCDs are all identical. After inventory, we streamlined the contents of each equipment box, and eventually we will have one small, one medium, and three large sets of diving outfits. Hydrostatic testing has been recently completed on all the divers' tanks and pony bottles. We considered a furniture dolly for storing tanks beneath the pontoon craft and for ease of moving tanks to our vehicles.

In July, we will conduct sonar training and dive from the boat next month at Patagonia Lake State Park. If wishing to carpool, meet at Rob Offerle's at 07:00. Otherwise, carpool at 08:00 from the lot at I-10 and AZ-83 (Sonoita Highway) or meet at 09:00 at the Patagonia boat ramp.

Our August training is to be announced.



Sat June 02 13/46/ ??yf hiker ankle injury 7 Falls, Bear Canyon, Catalinas Sheriff1 RMFD

11:45 – 13:45 A female hiker injured her ankle near 7 Falls. She was splinted and hoisted by Sheriff1.

Fri June 08 14/17/ 17ym hiker exhausted Sabino Canyon Trail, Catalinas

No field times A hiker reported exhausted on the Sabino Canyon Trail made it out before teams arrived.

Sun June 10 17/67/ Four hikers exhausted Sabino Basin, Catalinas Sheriff1

18:10 – 20:20 Four males hiked from Marshall Gulch to Sabino Canyon. Below Romero Pass, two were moving slowly so the other two moved ahead and asked for help when one had cell coverage. A SAR officer met the second one near the Dam Site and left refreshments, then continued to Pine Creek Crossing and met the remaining two. All hiked out with support from teams.

Thu June 14 12/29/ 20yf hiker exhausted x2 Bear Canyon Trail, Catalinas TucsonRanger RMFD

14:15 – 15:00 A male and female with 11mo old baby got a late start and hiked to 7 Falls. On the way back, the female became exhausted near x2, then became unresponsive. The Hasty team soaked her with water and she revived. She was carried out by stokes.

Tue June 19 10/45/ 16ym mtn bike leg injury Aspen Draw Trail, Catalinas MLFL

19:30 – 21:25 A mountain bike rider crashed about halfway down Aspen Draw. A short haul system was needed to help get the stokes back on trail, then he was carried down to the ski area.

Fri June 22 13/76/31ym hiker ankle injury Box Camp drainage, Catalinas Sheriff1 RMFD

18:10 – 22:00 Two hikers were coming down the Box Camp drainage and preparing a rappel when one slipped on gravel and injured his ankle. Sheriff 1 lowered a SAR officer in the area and he worked across steep terrain to the scene. Three hoists retrieved everyone as the Hasty Team arrived on the Box Camp Trail as it passed nearby. They continued down to the end of the road.

Sun June 24 14/97/50ym hiker exhausted Mt.Lemmon Trail, Catalinas Survey2

18:35 – 21:30 A hiker went down the Mt.Lemmon Trail to the Wilderness of Rocks, then started back up. Other hikers encountered him and left some water. He finally sat and waited. A large team arrived, provided refreshments, and all returned without problems.

Fri June 29 10/12/66ym bike rider missing 3 Points area

No field times On Wednesday afternoon, a male went for a motorcycle ride on his 3-wheeler and abandoned the bike when it became hi-centered. He was reported missing on Thursday afternoon, after family, friends and others had thoroughly covered his sign. A couple helicopters and officers looked for him on Thursday afternoon, and additional resources were requested for Friday morning. As the sun came up, the subject wandered out of the desert miles away, hungry and thirsty.
