NEW TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

This is a reminder of some training requirements that will go into effect soon:

Bloodborne Pathogens Awareness training - needs to be done annually. Check your status on the SARCI Field Qual Report (available on the SARCI Data page) in the "BBP" column. It shows the year and month (YYMM) that your training expires.

If you need this training, contact your team leadership.

AZBasicSAR – must have been done after 2012. Check your status on the SARCI Field Qual Report in the "AZ Basic" Column. If this field is shaded yellow you must take a current version of this training.

If you need this 16 hour training, advise Records of your availability so we can schedule at appropriate times.

Sometime over the next few months these will formally become SARCI Field Qualification requirements. Don't delay!



Sun July 01 14/97/ 2 hikers lost

Finger Rock, Catalinas

Survey2

22:35-06:25 Two hikers took the social trail to Finger Rock and called for help getting back. Teams met them below Finger Rock and all walked out slowly without problems.

Thu July 05 11/77/4 hikers and K9 lost Green Mtn, Catalinas

21:40-02:30 A group started hiking at the upper trailhead. While returning from Guthrie, they took the trail down Bear. When they were nearly at the lower trailhead they realized that they needed to go the other way. At the saddle they thought that it would be easier to go up over Green Mtn, and called for help when that didn't work. Teams met them up the ridge and all hiked out to the lower trailhead.

Sun July 08 11/40/11ym hiker exhausted Bear Canyon Trail, Catalinas RMFD

12:00-13:45 A female was reported unable to continue at about x5 in Bear Canyon. As initial resources approached the trailhead, a group appeared to match the description but said that they had not called for help. Teams covered the trail and drainage to x7 without finding the subject. Another call reported a hiker down and unresponsive on the trail near the parking lot. This group was the one that had claimed they didn't call for help. The patient in serious condition was packaged and carried to the parking lot.

Sat July 21 14/31/40ym runner exhausted Mt.Kimball, Catalinas

Sheriff1 RMFD

14:10 – 15:20 A group of runners reached Mt.Kimball. As they started down, one began having seizures and cramps. Sheriff1 lowered a Rescue Officer to the trail junction and the patient was hoisted up and delivered to the Overlook LZ. The Hasty Team reached the Overlook before returning.

Sat July 21 10/40/22ym hiker lost

Romero Canyon, Catalinas

19:20 – 21:25 A hiker intended to go up Romero and down Sutherland Trails, and had spent more than one day on the hike. He did not notice the trail climb a side drainage to Romero Pass, and called for help further up the main drainage. A Rescue Officer was lowered to the area and the patient was hoisted up and delivered to the Catalina State Park LZ. The Hasty Team reached Saddle3 with the second team close behind.

Sun July 22 9/30/28yf anxiety issues Main Falls, TV Canyon, Rincons

16:45 – 18:30 A group hiked to the Main Falls. As they started back, one had incapacitating anxiety issued, partly due to fear of heights on the first downclimb in the canyon bottom. As the team gained her confidence, she was able to walk with them down a different route, and continue downstream. She made it up the SARA Trail without problems.

Sat July 28 18/109/ 24ym hiker ankle injury 7 Falls, Bear Canyon, Catalinas RMFD

13:20 – 18:30 A male slipped on rocks above the first pool at 7 Falls, injuring his ankle. As a Rescue Officer reached the scene, the patient had moved down to the first pool. He was able to slowly walk down trail with his ankle wrapped tightly with a SAM splint, and reached the Horse Around where a ride was waiting. He was a very large person, fortunately one of the horses was large enough.

Sun July 29 21/78/ 33yf hiker ankle injury 7 Falls, Bear Canyon, Catalinas Sheriff1

11:00-14:25 A 33yf hiker injured her ankle near the base of the falls and she was unable to bear weight. The Hasty Team packaged her for a hoist by Sheriff1 and she was delivered to the Overlook LZ.

Mon July 30 <u>8/</u> <u>24/</u> 82ym hiker exhausted Blacketts Trail junction, Catalinas RMFD

08:45-10:10 A hiker returning from the top of Blacketts became exhausted. Companions thought he may have had a stroke, so a couple of helicopters were requested. The medical team found no symptoms of stroke, just dehydration. He was carried by stokes.
