Multi-Factor Authentication

Microsoft has been saying for years that they will enforce multi-factor authentication for all users of its Microsoft 365 platform. This is a basic part of modern security and is probably part of your life already in some form. This will likely be turned on by default with the next class and with new accounts moving forward.

TECHICAL UPDATE: CLUTCH

On or before July 1 (Monday) our technical kits will have the MPDs removed and replaced with Clutch devices. At that point, those without a Clutch Supplement will not be field qualified. Wednesday night was the last of many opportunities over the past year to complete a Clutch Supplement.


There are 15 members, who are otherwise field qualified that will be impacted by this. You will be shown as BASIC Qual (Green) at the end of this month. Please check your ERM "My Certifications" entries for "Rope Skills" are correct.

If you have a Clutch Supplement document (or Rope Skills taskbook) that is not reflected in ERM, please:

- 1. Upload an image of the document to your "My Certifications" in ERM
 - a. The image will be forwarded to Records
- 2. Send a note to *Records@sarci.org*.

I understand there will be an opportunity to complete a Clutch Supplement one hour before the SARA General Meeting on July 5. After that I believe a new (Clutch based) technical task book will be required.





All trainings are tentative until they appear on the Master Calendar and are announced via email.

All Level signoffs are available at all trainings; field signoffs are available at Personal Rope Skills, Field Trainings, Tower Trainings, and quarterly major Technician Trainings. No signoffs are available at Technician Team Meetings.

This year we are due for our MRA Technical recertification, so stay tuned for prep dates for that recertification.

Clutch Supplements and Taskbooks can now be found under "My Stuff" in ERM. If you prefer paper to be able to view it all in one place, those materials can still be found on the SARA Documents page, but all taskbooks will now be managed through ERM.

The Clutch Supplement was due on 7/1/2024 or you will lose FQ status. Your overall rope skills taskbook reverted to whatever level Clutch supplement you've completed on 7/1/2024.
