JANUARY MONTHLY TRAINING

January's monthly training topic will be: Tanque Verde Falls Orientation with a steep angle technical training following the orientation. Tanque Verde Falls/Canyon missions are some of the most intense rescues we do. This is due to the terrain and typical nature and severity of the injuries. Because the canyon is a series of waterfalls, it is critical that the hasty team takes the correct path to get to the injured subject. Taking the wrong path means climbing back out of the canyon and choosing the correct path which can cause critical delays to the rescue.

The orientation is a required Orange Card sign-off for SARA candidates. The orientation portion highlights the popular areas of the canyon, known routes to access patients, landing zones, anchor locations and locations of previous rescues in the area. Even if you've been around a while a refresher on the canyon is always helpful. The steep angle technical training is optional and will utilize some of the natural and embedded anchors introduced during the orientation.

Helmets and rescue packs are required for the orientation. Bring your harness, gloves, and other technical gear if planning to participate in the steep angle training (team gear will be provided). As always, dress appropriately for the weather, be aware of wildlife and other outdoor hazards, and be respectful of people recreating in the area!

AZ SAR TRACKER TRAINING

Mohave SAR will be leading an AZ SAR Tracker III/II training at SARA House on Saturday, January 25, 08:00-17:00 (*RSVP*). This training is open to all SARCI members and will provide the ASARCA-approved Tracker III and Tracker II classroom curricula needed for task book signoffs. Topics include mental preparedness, tracking techniques, clue awareness and preservation, equipment, and team positions and functions. There is a limited outdoor component to this training. Tracker III field evaluation opportunities are also possible but dependent on time and number of people attempting the test. Bring your full rescue pack, a tracking stick (trekking poles work!), tape measure, notepad, and pen/pencil. Printed task books will be provided. Digital copies can also be previewed at <u>https://arizonasar.com/sar-taskbooks/</u>.

Additionally, Mohave SAR will provide a small-group Instructor/Evaluator session at SARA House on Friday, January 24, 1400-1700, and Tracker II field evaluations, location TBD, on Sunday, January 26, 0800-1200. Emails were sent out to individuals previously expressing interest in and readiness for one or both these sessions. If you did not receive an email and should have, let me know! (Note: you must have already completed the Tracker III field evaluation to test at the Tracker II level.).

TECHNICAL SKILLS: TASKBOOKS

After the rush of signoffs in October and November, I'd like to draw everyone's attention to the number of tech taskbooks that expire throughout 2025:

If your taskbook is one of the 50+ that expire in Oct or Nov, I recommend you turn around a taskbook ASAP and get yourself onto a month with very few other folks asking for signoffs. This will also give you more 1:1 time on the new skills. Great choices to complete a new taskbook are: Feb, Mar, Jun, and December.

Starting in 2025 we may change the way SALT taskbooks expire so that we don't just contribute more and more to the same problem year after year. In the mean time, please consider getting yourself off the "SALT schedule" of taskbook expiration as soon as possible.

Kudos to all the Technicians who helped with signoffs, SALT, and the MRA recert, all at the same time of year. And kudos to everyone who has already completed one of the new taskbooks just implemented in September!

COMMUNICATIONS

The new UHF and VHF antennas connected to the N7SAR repeaters are at the very top of the tower (see picture) on Radio Ridge. A UHF combiner will be installed at some point which will use the UHF antenna at the top as a receive antenna for 4 UHF systems and one below it as a transmit antenna for 4 UHF systems. There will be no expected impact to performance.

Many people have recently obtained or are planning to obtain their amateur radio licenses. This is a reminder that if you want to use your FCC Part 90 type accepted personal radio on PimaSAR and StateSAR you must fill out and return for approval a Personal Radio Approval form. 

2025 TECHNICAL SCHEDULE

Hello all, please look ahead at the 2025 schedule and plan when you will tackle your taskbooks. There are six kinds of technical rope rescue trainings available in 2025:

- 1. Monthly meetings all non-field sign-offs
- 2. * Operations/Teamwork trainings all signoffs
- 3. Tower Training prioritize Tech skills (*orange card signoff available if you own a harness and are on the top of the tower to assist in team operations)
- 4. * Cliff trainings prioritize Tech skills and scene size-up in unique training locations
- 5. * Special trainings (steep angle, minimal gear, cave, etc.) taskbook signoffs may or may not be available
- 6. Personal Rope Skills focus on Rappelling/Belaying, climbing rope, personal on-rope skills (no Orange Card signoffs, but other taskbook signoffs are available)

The Orange Card signoff (denoted by * above) is intended to have Candidates participate in teamwork/operations, not just work on their personal signoff skills alone. Keep that in mind when you request an Orange Card signoff at any training.

At these trainings, participants will get a variety of hands-on technical rope equipment and setups. Signoffs are available at all levels of the taskbook at most trainings. All recent SALT graduates are welcome at any technical training unless otherwise specified. No visitors are permitted without advance permission from the Technician Team and in most cases a SAR Deputy. For all trainings: Bring your full rescue pack, helmet, headlamp, gloves, and any technical rescue gear you own. Wear weather-appropriate clothing and be aware of forecast weather conditions. Other gear will be team-provided.
