POLICY PROPOSAL UPDATES

After feedback from our January monthly meeting and suggestions sent to the Board of Directors, we have integrated your ideas into our policy proposals. You will find Revision 2 with the totality of changes highlighted in yellow at the following link: [4d - 2025-01-15 Proposed SARA Policy Changes rev2.pdf](#)

As a reminder, the core of the proposals include:

- Expansion of what is considered activity for a membership dues waiver (I.F.)
- Expansion of the Code of Conduct with four key components (I.J.2,3,4,5)
 - Equal Opportunity: Reaffirming our commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion
 - Sexual Harassment: Enhancing our guidelines and procedures to ensure a harassment-free environment
 - Anti-Violence: Establishing clear expectations for maintaining a respectful and non-threatening community
- Updated Disciplinary Policy (Appendix C)
 - Realigned policies to remove contradictions and clarify procedures
 - Provide tools to aid in reconciliation after disciplinary action
- Change of field qualification requirements for bloodborne pathogens (I.G.2.f)
 - Training interval has been increased from 12 to 24 months
 - Aligns with Arizona Search and Rescue Coordinators Association updated policy

We encourage all members to review these updates and give us feedback.

Due to the substantive nature of the changes made since the last monthly meeting, we will be restarting the process and taking feedback at the next two monthly meetings, which are on February 7 and March 7. Feedback can also be submitted directly to the Board at private-sarabod@scarci.org. If there are no substantive changes by the March 7 meeting, these policies will be formally voted on at the March 20 Board of Directors meeting. The full details of amending the Membership policy are outlined in the excerpt from the policy below:

K. Membership Policy Amendments

1. The proposed amendment will be submitted to the Board for consideration at a regular Board meeting.
2. The Board will publish the text of the amendment in a standard edition of the monthly SARCI Newsletter, or by mailing or e-mailing the amendment to each Member.
3. The amendment will be placed on the agenda for discussion at the next general meeting following publication.
4. At least a quorum of the Board must be present at the general meeting to explain and/or justify the amendment.
5. If there are any material changes to the amendment as a result of the discussion at the general meeting, a revised amendment must be submitted to the Board, starting the process from the beginning.
6. If no material changes were made, the Board may vote on the amendment at a regular Board meeting at least two (2) months following the submission of the most recent amendment at which time it shall become effective. Notice of the final outcome will be published in the SARCI Newsletter and on the SARA website.

1.5 hours Trauma

1.25 hours Medical

This session will also count for 2.5 hours of wilderness CME credit towards your SARA requirement of 8 hours of wilderness CME per 2-year recertification cycle.

TECHNICAL SKILLS: TASKBOOKS

After the rush of signoffs in October and November, I'd like to draw everyone's attention to the number of tech taskbooks that expire throughout 2025:

If your taskbook is one of the 50+ that expire in Oct or Nov, I recommend you turn around a taskbook ASAP and get yourself onto a month with very few other folks asking for signoffs. This will also give you more 1:1 time on the new skills. Great choices to complete a new taskbook are: Feb, Mar, Jun, and December.

Starting in 2025 we may change the way SALT taskbooks expire so that we don't just contribute more and more to the same problem year after year. In the meantime, please consider getting yourself off the "SALT schedule" of taskbook expiration as soon as possible.

Kudos to all the Technicians who helped with signoffs, SALT, and the MRA recert, all at the same time of year. And kudos to everyone who has already completed one of the new taskbooks just implemented in September!

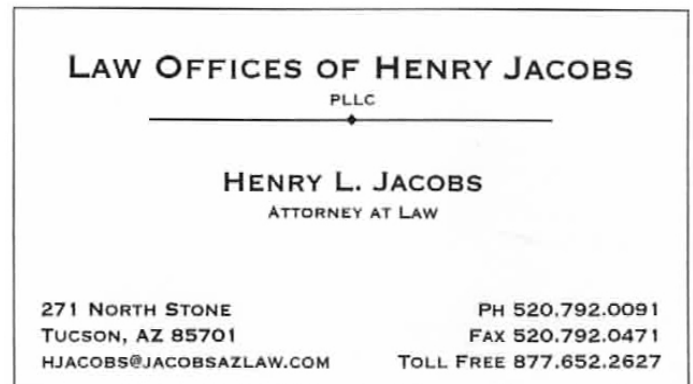
We all should strive to be good stewards of the airwaves when we are using the many types of radios at our disposal. Here's a reminder of why it's important to adhere to FCC rules:

2025 TECHNICAL SCHEDULE

Hello all, please look ahead at the 2025 schedule and plan when you will tackle your taskbooks. There are six kinds of technical rope rescue trainings available in 2025:

1. Monthly meetings - all non-field sign-offs
2. * Operations/Teamwork trainings - all signoffs
3. Tower Training - prioritize Tech skills (*orange card signoff available if you own a harness and are on the top of the tower to assist in team operations)
4. * Cliff trainings - prioritize Tech skills and scene size-up in unique training locations
5. * Special trainings (steep angle, minimal gear, cave, etc.) - taskbook signoffs may or may not be available
6. Personal Rope Skills - focus on Rappelling/Belaying, climbing rope, personal on-rope skills (no Orange Card signoffs, but other taskbook signoffs are available)

*The Orange Card signoff (denoted by * above) is intended to have Candidates participate in teamwork/operations, not just work on their personal signoff skills alone. Keep that in mind when you request an Orange Card signoff at any training.*

At these trainings, participants will get a variety of hands-on technical rope equipment and setups. Signoffs are available at all levels of the taskbook at most trainings. All recent SALT graduates are welcome at any technical training unless otherwise specified. No visitors are permitted without advance permission from the Technician Team and in most cases a SAR Deputy. For all trainings: Bring your full rescue pack, helmet, headlamp, gloves, and any technical rescue gear you own. Wear weather-appropriate clothing and be aware of forecast weather conditions. Other gear will be team-provided.

 14:03 – 15:36 An exhausted hiker called for help from the top of Bobcat Ridge. The group was served refreshments and all walked out without problems.
