

Do you know about Mission Data? It can be found by clicking "Responses" and then you'll see the "Mission Data" button near the top of the screen. To add your own information - coords, photos, team updates, etc - click "GPS" from the home screen, and then use the "+" button to the right of "Current Position."

MARCH MONTHLY TRAINING

The March monthly training will be an **area search simulation** in the vicinity of the Gilbert Ray Campground on **March 8, 2025**. This exercise will provide an opportunity for ground personnel to practice participating in an area search and searching a segment for a lost subject and relevant clues, and for the SARA IMT Planning Section to prepare for and manage an area search operation for one operational period. The IMT Planning Section will operate remotely out of an Incident Command Post (ICP) at a location TBD. Gilbert Ray Campground will be the staging area for ground teams.

Classroom Session: An optional <u>but recommended</u> classroom session will be conducted on Wednesday, March 5, from 18:00-20:00 at the SARA House. We will review the following:

- Fundamentals of an area search
- Search tactics and the handling of clues
- ICS forms used in an area search
- Use of the CalTopo app for tracking in an area search

Rendezvous: During a multiday search operation, an operational period will typically run from 06:00-18:00. **There will be an incident briefing at 07:00 at the Gilbert Ray Campground** (at the start of Operational Period 1 under our scenario) where teams will receive their search assignments, deploy to the field, search their assigned segments, and then return to the ICP to debrief.

Besides the operational procedures involved in a ground search, participants will familiarize themselves with processing clues, the Incident Command System (ICS) forms used and some of the tools involved, such as CalTopo.

Ground personnel should bring their full rescue pack and be prepared to perform a grid search of their assigned segment, in potentially rough terrain.

TECHNICAL SKILLS: TASKBOOKS

After the rush of signoffs in October and November, I'd like to draw everyone's attention to the number of tech taskbooks that expire throughout 2025:

<u>Month</u>	Expiring Taskbooks	<u>Month</u>	Expiring Taskbooks
January	5	July	7

If your taskbook is one of the 50+ that expire in Oct or Nov, I recommend you turn around a taskbook ASAP and get yourself onto a month with very few other folks asking for signoffs. This will also give you more 1:1 time on the new skills. Great choices to complete a new taskbook are: Feb, Mar, Jun, and December.

Starting in 2025 we may change the way SALT taskbooks expire so that we don't just contribute more and more to the same problem year after year. In the meantime, please consider getting yourself off the "SALT schedule" of taskbook expiration as soon as possible.

Kudos to all the Technicians who helped with signoffs, SALT, and the MRA recert, all at the same time of year. And kudos to everyone who has already completed one of the new taskbooks just implemented in September!

COMMUNICATIONS

The FCC rules for communications on amateur radio frequencies (Lemmon, Lemmon Simplex, for example) require any transmission to come from a <u>licensed</u> amateur radio operator and for any transmission to follow the rules for proper identification using an FCC callsign. SARA has licenses specifically for PimaSAR and StateSAR frequencies, but the Lemmon amateur frequencies we use are not our personal domain. Any amateur operator is free to use them. Please be good stewards of these frequencies. Otherwise, we run the risk of losing operating privileges.

Here is a reminder that if you want to use your FCC Part 90 type accepted personal radio on PimaSAR and StateSAR you must fill out and return for approval a Personal Radio Approval form. You can find the form at:

2025 24-HOURS-IN-THE-OLD-PUEBLO RECAP

SARA treated 95 riders at this year's 24 Hours in the Old Pueblo (24 HOP) mountain bike race. This number includes a few riders who returned for a change of dressing. While the number of riders treated was up, the seriousness of the injuries was down, with most of the injuries being the usual abrasions, cactus spines with several shoulder, collarbone or AC separations thrown in. One rider with an open fracture was transported by ground ambulance to Banner. A second rider with a non-race related severe allergic reaction was transported to Northwest Oro Valley. Thank you to the on-scene AMR Paramedic and EMT for their management of this latter case.

Twenty-three SARA members were involved in SARA's medical support of this year's 24 HOP. SARA members were also involved with race communications and administration (timing).

MONSTER 300 SUPPORT



2025 TECHNICAL SCHEDULE

Hello all, please look ahead at the 2025 schedule and plan when you will tackle your taskbooks. There are six kinds of technical rope rescue trainings available in 2025:

- 1. Monthly meetings all non-field sign-offs
- 2. * Operations/Teamwork trainings all signoffs
- 3. Tower Training prioritize Tech skills (*orange card signoff available if you own a harness and are on the top of the tower to assist in team operations)
- 4. * Cliff trainings prioritize Tech skills and scene size-up in unique training locations
- 5. * Special trainings (steep angle, minimal gear, cave, etc.) taskbook signoffs may or may not be available
- 6. Personal Rope Skills focus on Rappelling/Belaying, climbing rope, personal on-rope skills (no Orange Card signoffs, but other taskbook signoffs are available)

The Orange Card signoff (denoted by * above) is intended to have Candidates participate in teamwork/operations, not just work on their personal signoff skills alone. Keep that in mind when you request an Orange Card signoff at any training.

At these trainings, participants will get a variety of hands-on technical rope equipment and setups. Signoffs are available at all levels of the taskbook at most trainings. All recent SALT graduates are welcome at any technical training unless otherwise specified. No visitors are permitted without advance permission from the Technician Team and in most cases a SAR Deputy. For all trainings: Bring your full rescue pack, helmet, headlamp, gloves, and any technical rescue gear you own. Wear weather-appropriate clothing and be aware of forecast weather conditions. Other gear will be team-provided.
